English Section REGULAR CABLE SERVICE

From page 2nd. PARIS, 24.—It is officially announced that general fighting continues desperately, with heavy losses on both sides.

LONDON, 24.—A despatch from Ostend to the "Daily Telegraph" says that an Englishman who managed to get out of Brussels, states that the Germans passed through that city in a southerly direction and as rapidly as possible; that it is calculated that more than 200,000 have passed through in 48 hours; that they continue to pass through after the occupation; that they are heavily equipped and are in good condition; that before he left he met some officers in a Cafe, who told him that the troops were marching from 30 to 40 miles a day; he also says he noticed that every detail was perfect; that of the numbers of cars that passed through none were examined; that all were constructed for military service and bore the Government mark; that they all were constructed for military service and bore the Government mark; that they carried sets of extra shoes for the horses, which hung from the stirrups, and that at Waterloo he saw a part of the artillery hurrying to Mons, and counted 230 cannons.

BERLIN, 24.—Wireless despatches transmitted to the Sayville station, United States, for the Associated Press, state that it is officially announced that the German army in command of the Duke Albrecht of Württemberg, defeated the French at Neufchatel, capturing several cannons, flags and prisoners, among them some Generals, and they are pursuing the enemy, who are retreating; that the Germans captured 150 cannons in Luneville, Blamint and Cirey where the body commanded by the Crown Prince forced the French out of Longwy and pursues them towards the west; that the Germans are on the west of the Meuse, and that they advanced against Maubenge, defeating an English cavalry brigade.

LONDON, 24.—The fighting line extends from Mons to Nancy; the allies amount to more than a million and the Germans one million two hundred thousand.

BASLE, 24.—According to news from different parts of Alsace, the Germans have taken the offensive, attacking Mulhouse and other points.

ST. PETERSBUR, 24.—The Russians have penetrated seven miles into German territory, with large forces which advance against Konigsberg, having already occupied Soldau and controlling the railway to Danzig. The Russian line on the frontier extends from Tilzit to Insterburg and Arzys, which endangers the German positions from Danzig to Thorn.

ATHENS, 24.—An official despatch from Nish announces the invasion of Hungary by the Serbians.

ST. PETERSBUR, 24.—In a report to General Rennenkampf, Commander of the Russian army in Germany, it is stated that the Russians control the greater part of eastern Prussia, having taken Insterburg, Gumbinnen, Ortelsburg, Johannsburg and Mardobowa, and controlling the railways.

ROTTERDAM, 24.—According to the most reliable information that can be obtained, the situation of the Germans, is as follows—their right wing occupies the territory to the immediate south of Antwerp, and is moving southwesterly in direction of Lille; a second division advances towards Maubenge, and the third is occupied in the taking of the forts at Namur. It is calculated that all these forces total nearly four million men, and that the main body of the north, which amounts to 300,000 men, advances with a front which extends from Givet to Dierdenhoften. It is believed that their objective is the attack of the allies, line of defense, which extends from La Fare to Rheims, and that the main body of the south, which is in Strasburg, will try to force back the line of defence from Verdum to Nancy.
