Von Dergoltz has arrived at Constantinople

AMSTERDAM, 14th.—Telegrams from Berlin inform that the Kaiser's health is very much improved and that he will be able to return to the field this week.

CONSTANTINOPLE, 14th.—Von Der Goltz has arrived accompanied by the German military attaches which were stationed at Biebrach and Sofia. At the station he was received by the heir apparent who welcomed him and gave him a medal in the name of the Sultan.

LONDON, 14th.—The "Daily Express" correspondent in Copenhagen says that people who have arrived from Berlin state that the illness of the Kaiser is very serious and that there is great alarm throughout Germany.

PARIS, 14th.—An official report says: There is nothing important to report between the Oise and the region of the Aisne, North-west of Soirp.

BERLIN, (By way of London), 14th.—An official report says: Light attacks by the French have taken place in several parts of our positions between the Meuse and the Vosges.

WOMAN SUFFRAGE LEADERS READY FOR CONVENTION

NASHVILLE, TENN., Dec.—There is considerable agitation in suffrage circles and a great deal of preparation on the part of those connected with the movement for the national convention, which takes place here Nov. 12 to 17.

PETROGRAD, 14th.—A Caucasian official report says: Throughout Friday fighting occurred on the front, through the villages of Pyrnok, Assner and Tufak.

PARIS, 14th.—An official report says: There has been no engagement of importance in any front. In the region of Miawa we continue to force back the Germans who are retreating.

land an enemy like them is worthy of esteem. In answer to some questions relative to the situation in the western arena he said: "Millions of Germans are fighting in enemy's territory and occupy the richest French provinces. We under estimate the opponents (French and British) which fight with utter contempt for death but we are gradually gaining ground and we are convinced that the day is not far when the enemy's resistance will be broken. Germany is prepared to fight for many years to come.

WASHINGTON, 14th.—Colonel Goehals confirmed his demands for two destroyers. Owing to the confidential character of the dispatch same has not been published.

LONDON, 14th.—The "Daily News" correspondent in Petrograd says that the fight continues incessantly. The Germans are centering all efforts in the operations which are being carried out in the region of Lovicz.

PARIS, 15th.—The Prime Minister Viviani, in company of the Minister Leon Bourgeois, has continued visiting the districts of the Aisne, the Somme and the Pas de Calais.

WASHINGTON, 15th.—General Carranza, through United States Consul Canada, informed the Department of State, that any use of strength made by the American troops located at Naco.

BERLIN, (By way of London) 14th.—The "Taseblatt" correspondent in the region of the Meuse and the Moselle, said that he discovered that the Germans are no savages. Life in Belgium is just as it was in time of peace.

AEROGRAMS.

Street lights in Paris are ordered to be put out

LONDON, 15th.—The Official Information Bureau today gave out the following statement: After a period of comparative quiet the fighting in Northern France has commenced; a combined attack by the Allies was made yesterday on the line from Holleheke to Wyteschote in Belgium; several German trenches and a number of prisoners were captured, and substantial progress made.

PARIS, 15th.—All the street lights in Paris were extinguished at midnight; the reason for this precaution stated to have been the receipt of a report that two zeppelins had been sighted at Amiens, proceeding towards Paris.

ZEVENAAAR, POLAND, 15th.—The two German officers who had been war prisoners here and who violated their parole by escaping across the border into Germany were returned yesterday under orders of the German Government.

LONDON, 15.—Belgrade, the unfortified capital of Serbia which the Austrians occupied about two weeks ago, after a long bombardment is again in the hands of the Serbians.

BERLIN, 15th.—A dispatch from the Southwest war zone reports a violent artillery duel Sunday in the upper Alsace, arising apparently from an attempt by the French to advance in the direction of Altkirch the fighting lasted from 7 a. m. Sunday until late in the afternoon; the outcome has not been reported.
