THE TIMES Port Limon, Costa Rica (G. A.) SHIPS FOR THE MIKADO'S NAVY.

That the notable efforts made and still continuing to improve the facilities of the private ship-building yards of Japan have been vindicated is shown by the action of the naval authorities in giving notice to the Mitsui Bishi and Kawasaki yards that an order will be placed with each for the construction of an armored cruiser of 27,000 tons, to be the same in almost every respect as the armored cruiser ordered from a British ship-building yard last year.

These are to be of the latest form in design, equipment and construction, and in no way inferior in detail to the most powerful vessels of the same type now being built by the strongest naval countries of the world.

This is a notable departure, for with the improvement of the private yards to a point which enables them to turn out the largest battleships and cruisers which may be called Japan's naval construction autonomy witnessed a highly important extension. Never before have these private yards attempted anything so ambitious, and in view of this circumstance they will be assisted at the outset by the navy, both as regards the work of construction and the supply of materials.

To build the ships at these yards will cost more than to build them at a domestic naval yard or abroad, but Japan finds compensation for this financial loss in the greater independence which the precedent will be for her in the sphere of armaments.

Another armored cruiser is to be built at the Yokosuka yard, and the keel will be laid down shortly. One more battleship has to be built under the latest programme formulated by the navy, and the work will be undertaken by the Kure yard. The keels of all four vessels will be laid down at an early date.

Commenting on the announcement that the Japanese navy has placed orders with the private yards at Kobe and Nagasaki for two cruisers of nearly twenty-seven thousand tons, the Liberal News Agency declares that this news has aroused a certain amount of nervousness among the Powers. A well known naval officer is quoted to the effect that this departure from a virtual government warship-building monopoly, with the exception of a few destroyers and small cruisers marks an important era in the history of the Japanese navy and of the art of ship-building in this

country. It is pointed out that even in England, where this industry is most highly developed, the tonnage of a cruiser launched at a private yard in January last was only 22,670 tons. Thus the fact that ships of superior tonnage have been ordered from the private yards of Japan should be subject of sincere congratulation.

Lloyds will not Accept Liability For War Risks.

London.—Lloyds Underwriters have given notice that they will not accept liability for war risks under marine insurance contracts after August 8th. The decision is believed to have been prompted partly by the Moroccan difficulty and partly by the Government's approval of the Declaration of London.

Train Derailed.

Wails a banana train was coming from ahead. In and with bananas and near Moins crossing, the rail split in two following the locomotive off the track. News was at once sent to Limon and the wrecking car with a gang of men was despatched to the scene of disaster. After a few hours hustling all was right again and the passenger train was able to pass.

United Fruit Co. Yields.

New York.—As a result of a conference between Capt. Anderson, marine superintendent of the United Fruit Company, and representatives of the crews, the latter announced that an agreement was reached and the war of the marine unions against the company was suspended pending the signing of papers embodying the terms of settlement.

W. H. Frazier, chairman of the union committee, said that the agreement will apply to all the crews of the company engaged in New York, Boston, Philadelphia, Baltimore, Mobile and New Orleans.

He said that under the terms of settlement the firemen will be paid 40dols. a month, the coal passers and sailors 30dols. and the quartermasters 35dols. The waiters are to receive 22dols. 50c. a month, the pantrymen, 40dols.; the chief cook on each vessel, 75dols.; the second cook, 50 dols.; the third cook, 30dols.; the ship's cook or butcher, 35dols.; the baker, 55dols.; the second baker, 30dols.; and the cook's mate, 25dols. The wages of the men in the other department were said to be satisfactory.

No German Base on Coast of Africa.

London.—That Germany will get compensation in Africa as a result of her descent upon Agadir and in return for the free hand which France is seeking in Morocco, is conceded here; but it is also clear that Great Britain is not going to permit the establishment of a German naval base on the Coast of Africa if she can prevent it.

Great Britain's great trade routes to South America, South Africa and the Far East all pass within striking distance of Agadir, Morocco, and generations of British statesmen have maintained that to allow a possibly hostile power to establish itself on the flank of these lines of communication would be a vital menace to this country. There would be, however, no objection here to France giving compensation in the shape of a rectification of the German and French Congo boundary, provided that it does not include a change of ownership of the coast line detrimental to this country.

The activity of the Foreign Office was again marked, the indications pointing to the near approach of a stage where the crisis either will become ardently violent or commence to dissolve. The composition of the group of Ministers actively handling the situation—the Premier, Sir Edward Grey and Mr. David Lloyd George—shows that the British Government is solid while the fact that Sir Francis Bertie, the British Ambassador to France, and Mr. Paul Cambon, the French Ambassador at London, have been called into the conferences, proves the continued solidarity of the Anglo-French entente.

King Alfonso also appeared on the scene having arrived at Portsmouth on the Spanish Royal yacht "Girelda" and immediately came into London where he conferred with Sir Edward Grey. The King is remaining in town and messengers pass frequently between Buckingham Palace and the Foreign Office.

Unless an arrangement is reached in the meantime, the Atlantic Fleet, the projected visit of which to Norway was cancelled, will be sent back probably to its base at Gibraltar at the end of the week.

Robbery Followed Sympathy.

Benjamin Reid was drunk and lie down near the track line, nearly opposite to where the engine take water, in the direction of the crossing. Some breaksmen had an eye to business and feigned sympathy for the man, and took him to the rear of a nearby yard and there placed him for safety (that is out of other people's sight). While the man slept, he being hopelessly drunk, his would-be sympathizers extracted fifteen dollars gold from his pocket. The man came from the lines and he declared that was all the money he had with him. The poor fellow looking around saw none to give him aid burst into tears, declaring he was unable to return to the country. A good Samaritan, in the person of a woman, gave him 50 cents, and with this the man became a bit cheerful.

Alleged Attempt to Late Departure of Commit Arson. Train.

Four men were apprehended and lodged in the cartel on Wednesday night last, to be charged with attempting to set fire to the premises of one Paul, a St. Lucian, opposite Parlo's grocery and next to the restaurant, which is at the corner of Fifth Street and Third Avenue.

From information obtained it is learnt that a cartman applied on the premises for a room to hire and was shown one by the proprietor. A quantity of straw was on the floor which the proprietor said could be put into a bit of canvas, which he applied, and put into a dirt pan that is kept beneath a long staircase that leads up to the upper story.

The straw was accordingly tied up by the cartman that intended to hire the room and put into the pan about 6.30 p.m. with the intention of putting it out next morning. In the room four men (it is said loafers) were accustomed to sleep at night. An over-vigilant policeman came across the bundle of straw beneath the step and probably suspected that it was a plot to set fire to the house took the four men in charge and landed them in the college. Three of them were released later on and the other will be charged before the court.

Earthquake Shock.

At about twenty-five minutes past eleven on Wednesday night last Limon was visited by a severe earthquake, which lasted about twenty seconds, and which must have alarmed many persons. It is said by a few that experienced the shock at Cartago, that ruined the ancient capital, that it was almost as hard.

Current News.

The "Prinz Wilhelm" arrived yesterday afternoon from New York via Jamaica and Colon.

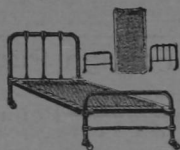

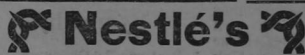
