THE TIMES Port Limon, Costa Rica (C. A.) PREPARE TO CROWN EMPEROR OF INDIA

The next great event for which King George and Queen Mary are preparing is, of course, the Indian durbar, and this week much of the equipment has been despatched, including the travelling and reception tents, which have been made after the model of, but more extensive than, those made for the Duke and Duchess of Connaught and Princess Patricia during their African tour. The King has given further commissions to certain jewelry firms for articles of various descriptions, with the royal monogram, to serve as presents while in India.

Delhi-Ko-Bahar is the title with which the King Emperor will be hailed at the durbar. No official programme is yet ready, but the work of preparation is well advanced, and it is pretty well known what it will be like. It involves almost the reconstruction of the city—roads, railways and sanitation all being extensively improved.

King George is the first of the English to be crowned Delhi-Ko-Bahar. He himself will perform the act of crowning, as no religious ceremony, is possible in a land full of so many jarring creeds as in India. For King George and Queen Mary special crowns are being made at the crown jewellers. They will be of a characteristic Indian type and will be assumed by them with their own hands at the durbar on December 12.

The King and Queen will be in Delhi from December 7 to December 16. The King then leaves for a shooting expedition to Nepal, when he will be the guest in a shooting camp of the Maharajah, the Queen remaining at Agra.

Among the ceremonies fixed is a state entry into Delhi, presentation of the inevitable addresses and the reception of several thousand Indians in a pavilion on the historic ridge where the British camp was during the mutiny days.

Two days are set apart for visits from the ruling chiefs, the King being anxious to come into personal touch with them, and for these two days he will do nothing else than converse with the rulers of native India. This is looked upon as a stroke of very wise policy, due entirely to the King's comprehension of the Indian problem, in which he is known to have taken a deep interest, and it is considered that it will make permanent the good effects of his visit to India. The King will not return the visits, in that respect his place being taken by Lord Hardinge, who, when the King steps ashore at Bombay, ceases to be Viceroy and becomes the Governor General.

The durbar will be witnessed by at least 50,000 persons. The scene is expected to be overwhelmingly splendid even to the Indian mind, which expects a great deal. There is to be another day a review of eighty thousand troops. Calcutta children will sing the national anthem in that city in four languages—English, Gujarati, Marathi and Urdu.

Tortured in Panama Jail.

The following extraordinary story, cabled from Colon has been published in serious New York newspapers:—

William Harrington, a machinist in the employ of the Panama Canal Commission, was driven insane and tortured to death recently in a Panama prison, according to his brother, a lawyer of San Francisco. The brother is here investigating the case with a view to having the American State Department put in a heavy claim for damages.

Harrington's sole offence, it is alleged, is that he refused to pay for a bottle of beer. He was placed in the stocks of the penal camp at Porto Bello and confined there sixty days. Following the discovery of the fact, fellow employees raised such a storm of indignation that the authorities had physicians examine the prisoner. It is charged that Harrington was made insane by the treatment he got in jail and that he was out of his mind thirty days before he died. Various punishments are alleged to have been inflicted upon him.

Surprised by Constables.

Siloah.—This place was thrown into a state of excitement when it was reported that an alleged obahman had been captured by Constable J. A. Levy and District Constable Salmon in the district of Thoroton.

On receiving certain information the limbs of the low lid himself in a convenient place and it is said that as soon as they started work he was caught. The alleged worker of the "black art," heard of a recent case Wright vs. Campbell which was tried at Balacava Courts. He, it is alleged, offered his services "to kill Campbell." The man was on his way to Lacovia with a donkey load of provisions. After his arrest he was taken to the police station. On arrival it was found out that the poor donkey he will thus have to answer two charges.

Payment of M. P'S.

London.—By a vote of 241 to 123, the House of Commons passed a resolution, appropriated £252,000 for the payment of salaries to members for the coming year. This action was taken pursuant to the resolution passed, providing for an annual salary of £400 for each member of the House of Commons. This is a radical departure from the principle of gratuitous public service hitherto prevailing in the House.

Drought in India.

London.—The King according to the "Daily Express" will probably not attend the Delhi Durbar owing to unprecedented dry weather which heralds a famine of great severity in India.

Earth Tremors.

Manila.—The seismograph here records a series of strong earthquake shocks occurring at an estimate distance of 2,000 miles from Manila. The tremors continued with evident violence for a period of two hours,

Current News.

An enjoyable evening was spent on board the s.s. "Prinz Joachim" on Friday night by the "elite" of this town who engaged themselves in dancing and other amusements.

What might have resulted in serious loss of life with the turning over of the crane in use at Tourisque on Tuesday can be reported has been due to accident. Old Frankie our popular "Boiler-maker" got off with slight bruises and apart from minor damages there is nothing to speak of.

Shipping News.

The s.s. "Harry T. Hinge" sailed with 18,000 bunches of fruit for New Orleans. She also carried mails for Europe.

The s.s. "San José" arrived with the following passengers: Mr. Samuel L. Lee, wife and three children, Mrs. W. W. McDonald and two children, Mr. Juan de Arce and wife, Mr. J. J. Vargas Calvo, Mr. J. Farrell, Mr. J. Beledori.

Interesting Items.

A cantaloupe train believed to be the longest the world has ever seen passed through Tucson, Ariz., recently from the Imperial Valley. The train consisted of 130 cars, was a mile and a half in length and contained more than 1,000,000 pounds of cantaloupes.

Women school teachers in the higher schools of Russia have put on the same wage schedule as men teachers, with the same rights in respect to pensions. Wherever discussion of the matter took place there was a strong feeling that women should receive equal pay with men for equal work.

A recent arrival from the interior of Panama relates a novel method of dentistry in practice among the inhabitants there. Instead of extracting an aching tooth by means of a forceps, they take the inner bark of a certain tree common in that section, pulverize it thoroughly and apply it to the tooth. The application is left on for some hours and in three or four days the tooth is so loose that it can be easily pulled out with the fingers.

Great Heat in Mediterranean.

Paris.—Scientists are perplexed at the sudden abnormal rise in the temperature of the Mediterranean Sea. The theory that is due to volcanic action has been advanced.

"Surely the English statesmen and leaders who are talking of universal peace and arbitration," the paper adds, "will do well to consider the problem of how to prevent a few thousands of workmen from putting the life of the nation to danger."

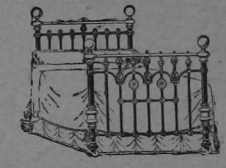

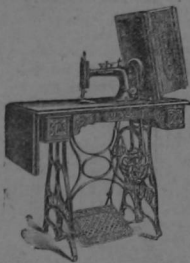

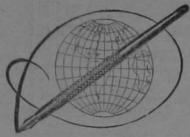
