## THE POSITION OF VICE-CONSUL.

It is learnt that in a few days hence Mr. Nutter Cox who is away on furlough will arrive here to take up his former position as Consul for His Britannic Majesty King George V. It will be remembered that some time after the departure of Mr. Cox for England, Mr. McGregor, then Vice-Consul was offered and accepted a more lucrative position abroad. With the relinquishing of his post with the United Fruit Company he resigned also the resignation of the honor of being Vice-Consul in Limon for King George V.

So the matter is settled without a hitch. Mr. Clauis Dismal was asked to accept the acting appointment, and it is learnt that with a bit of reluctance and modesty he accepted the temporary position. It is well known that the position was offered to other parties but they politely refused. Among them was Mr. Zuercher, who is believed to have made an ideal Vice-Consul, he having all the necessary qualifications, but probably did not want to leave his present position as a result of the amount of money that is attendant on such an office and perhaps for these reasons and many others he declined the honor which is much to be regretted.

We cannot always get what we require, and it is very often happens that which we desire is set out to be remitted to our wishes. It is a matter of regret that speculation is running high and that who will succeed Mr. McGregor permanently, for this honorable position that carries with it so little remuneration. It is public property that there has been a few applicants for the position, and the arrival of Mr. Cox will settle the matter as who will receive the happy choice. We have no doubt as to the manner Mr. Cox view this affair which is of great importance, one on which hangs the destiny of thousands of British subjects that is now residing in Costa Rica. This is a matter that requires deep thought and broad-mindedness, and the fact that it is believed would do justice to all ought to be selected, hence, it is one that is above party bias; he should be an independent individual; one that is not subservient to another, so that his hands cannot be considered as being in any way prejudicially affected. Mindfulness and a sense of duty, justice and love of doing what is right should be the characteristics of such a one appointed for the position.

The great importance of procedure in an independent mind is the fact that the salary attached to such a position is so low, that it precludes the acceptance of an independent man. It would be well if John Bull were to follow the lead of his cousin Uncle Sam who respects and upholds the dignity of their Vice-Consul by affording an adequate salary to the holder of the office. Not only this is done before a consultation and a final stamping man will be set.

We have not whether the holder of the present acting position will be offered the permanent appointment or not, but rumour has it that he will not accept it. It has been reported in many quarters that the temporary appointment

has been ably filled by Mr. Dismal, who we know has sacrificed much of his time to right the wrongs of many Jamaicans. But possibly there may be a day when this something will crop up where gentlemen's more lucrative position may be at stake, and here would come a severe test, and it is almost reasonable to predict the side he would take, which when all things considered, would be reasonable from a human point of view.

It has been urged that none but a Briton should be appointed, but we have had British failures and still can have failures. What the people want is a man of an enterprising and energetic nature, one who will stand up for a righteous cause, no matter what may be the seeming disadvantage, justice and fair play should always be his aim, and this is possible with one that has not to account to none but his chief at San Jose.

We hope for the sake of decency a proper man will be selected to represent Great Britain in Limon.

## The War.

The war has become absolutely uninteresting. Not an important engagement has yet taken place and Turkey is still showing the greatest anxiety that the Powers should step in and save her from a deplorable predicament. This is not likely to happen, unless Turkey consents to the abandonment of Tripoli, which is now practically in the hands of the Italians. The result of this is now being held over by the Turkish Government and is the basis of its European provinces if it does not hasten to make peace; and that this is a real danger to our country. But on the other hand, the Turkish Government has also to face the danger of its subjects. The new Sultan must realize that, whatever may have been his country's humiliations during his brother's reign, they were nothing compared to those of the present reign, and he must know that the new Government will become intensely unpopular if more serious losses have to be made to Christian Powers. What may follow this war is a revolution in Turkey. And that is what the country's rulers fear. Yet the inevitable has to be faced; do what she will, Turkey cannot retain Tripoli, any more than Spain could retain Cuba after the Americans had attacked that island. It seems clear that a grave crisis threatens the Turkish Empire, and nothing can avert it. Bosnia and Herzegovina gone; Tripoli going now. The Balkans will follow, and Constantinople. The writing on the wall is clear.

He was born in Edinburgh, in 1827, and was an associate of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle at Edinburgh. His fall was the result of mysterious circumstances.

GUAYAMA.—As a result of a disagreement with President Estrada, General Plaza has resigned his office as Minister of Finance and has been succeeded by Sr. Federico Lirioy. Sr. Antonio Berro, formerly President, died on October 11. He was eighty-four years old.

The spot being broken in by a seizer here. The osh worker will be dealt with in the same manner as all other persons as we are in possession of further evidence which we will give the authorities.

## Local News.

The ss, "Caribia," after arriving from Colon today will sail at 8.30 p.m. for New Orleans via Puerto Barrios and Guatemala. She will take passengers and mails.

The attention of the Health Officer is called to several small pools of water that is seen on several of the streets. Will not these small mosquitoes as the uncovered barrels that this officer and his staff very often make severe crasides, finding parties different causes. Who will be glad for this?

At last the city authorities have seen the necessity of erecting a water closet in the park. Truly waters never cease.

James William Nurse the Barbadian whose name is mentioned in the recent police investigation of the robbery of zinc from the pier returned from Nicaragua on Wednesday, and (arrived up to work yesterday morning, but a couple hours after he was apprehended by a police and lodged in Court.

The Criminal Judge has been engaged during the past week taking statements in the recent fire at Estrada. Several persons from the section were examined. An anonymous letter was sent to the Governor of Limon disclosing certain things relative to the fire and which it is understood tends to implicate somebody. The letter is in the hands of the Judge.

The "Joseph Vacara," consigned to the United Fruit Co. arrived here yesterday morning bringing a cargo of 584 tons, consisting of general merchandise, 3,500 cross ties, 20,000 feet lumber and a small consignment of apples and grapes. After discharging her cargo she will sail for Bocas del Toro.

On the 3rd January several arrests in connection with the gigantic Railway robbery took place since then one of the accused named Morgan skipped the country and is now employed in the Machine shops at Bocas, his fiador has not been asked for, two others—one of whom tried to skip his bail but was caught—are still here unmolested. Has the case dropped? Or will this latest robbery of corrugated iron from the Pier resurrect it?

## Strongest Forth.

It has always been known that Gibraltar, which belongs to Great Britain, is one of the strongest forts both for defence and offence in the world. It is said that an immense fleet could be sent to the bottom before getting within five miles of Gibraltar. Not even a torpedo boat could succeed in entering the bay unobserved on the blackest night. The most eminent naval experts are of the opinion that this world's greatest fortress is almost impregnable, according to Cassell's Saturday Journal.

Gibraltar never sleeps. By day and night two perfectly equipped signal stations, proudly flaunting Britain's flag of ownership, sweep the seas around to a distance of fifteen miles on a clear day, instantly reporting the coming and going of each vessel.

Modern "wooded" guns, the finest in Europe, are installed on all the most prominent points. They are unreachably from the sea, even as they are discernable, owing to the skill with which they are planted and draped to match the surrounding vegetation while huge search shells are fired. They have a range of fifteen miles and could drop shells on Cuba, in Africa, opposite, quite comfortably.

One gun weighs 110 tons and is capable of throwing a shell weighing three quarters of a ton in that marvel of engineering under great difficulties, the galleries are concealed guns for every day in the year.

These galleries are divided into three sections, entry to which is guarded, while one is closed even to high officers, containing preserved stores, munitions of war, rain water (for Gibraltar has no springs) and a complete condensing plant—all calculated to outlast a siege of seven years.

The firing is the most mathematically perfect imaginable. The surrounding waters are mapped into squares, upon which certain guns are kept ready trained, so that it is almost impossible to miss.

## Suffragette Tour.

Southampton.—Mrs. Emmeline Pankhurst and Miss Mary Pethick departed on board the steamer "Oceanic" for New York, to make a suffragette tour to America. The train that brought them here was decorated with suffragette colours. They got a demonstrative farewell on leaving London.

## Naval Secret.

Portsmouth, England.—Successful experiments with the wireless control of submarine boats have been made, but the details are kept secret. It is known, however, that a submarine was taken to shallow water off Seley where the Hertzian waves were worked by the cruiser "Furious."

The submarine, which won on the surface was manned, and was found to be entirely under the control of the cruiser. Then the crew was taken out and the experiment was equally successful when the boat was submerged.

Similar experiments are being made with torpedoes.
