

ATTACK ON KING GEORGE V.

Remarkable Open Letter Read by Minister in Church

In City of Liverpool.

GRAVER MATTERS TO ATTEND TO THAN ABSURDITY OF ROYAL CEREMONIES.

London.—A most remarkable attack has been made on the King by the Rev. Harry Yonlden, the clergyman who occupies the pulpit from which Dr. Aked, since, formerly preached in Liverpool.

The attack took the form of an open letter read in the course of a sermon. It began as follows:

"We owe you no loyalty except so far as the welfare of the nation depends on you. If we are cold amid the general excitement of your coronation day it is because we are not convinced that the greatest duty of the nation is bound up with the throne. We are not revolutionaries. There are greater matters to attend to than the absurdity of royal ceremonies. I have said this much for the sake of sincerity, and that I might clear myself of the company of those who are not greeting before you and behaving like pagans before a fetish."

Then the letter goes on:—"Would it make your coronation less real if you were accompanied to the Abbey by men from the tropes and the mine instead of by frogs? Although you choose to live for the world of soldiers, not by them is your throne supported. It is open to you to be patron of the arts."

You have bestowed honours which we at present despise because they have been wrongly bestowed. * * * Meanwhile genius is starving in its garret—starving unrecognized. Painters, singers, writers, actors, men of science, have to sell their souls to make a living. Nothing, sir, in your empire is so cheap as brains and genius; nothing so easily despised by the vulgar rich; nothing so tragically misunderstood and disregarded. You patronize the turf and stimulate the multitude to gamble on horses they never see. Your private tastes are not my concern; but if you are the head of this nation you must make yourself acquainted with more than its jockeys. The glory of kings in the past has been too much the glory of the sword and conquest. There is a greater glory within your reach if you have courage and discernment."

REIGN OF TERROR IN NICARAGUA.

Jails Crowded with Peaceful Citizens Who are Loaded With Chains.

Are Being Tortured.

COUNTRY SUBJECT TO THE WILL OF MINISTER OF WAR LUISS MENA.

(By D. W. I. Cable Co.)

Panama, July 18.—Reports from Granada, Nicaragua, declare that the jails of Managua are crowded with respectable and peaceful citizens who are loaded with chains.

Their only offence is opposition to the present Government. Many persons have been exiled, the wealthiest obtaining their liberty by paying large sums. The favorite torture applied by the present régime, it is alleged, is called "Cero De Cero" and consists in tying together the thumbs of the victim behind his head and suspending him thereby. From the crook of each elbow as many rifles are hung as the victim can bear without fainting.

In Masaya sixty political prisoners were locked for twenty-four hours in a bare floor room sixteen feet square.

The state of siege continues. The country is completely subject to the will of the Minister of War, General Mena.

The Government has suddenly prohibited the circulation of \$500. and \$1000. bills printed by order of Zelaya and Madriz, alleging that many are counterfeit. As millions of dollars of these bills are in circulation, much distress has been caused by the order.

Timely Warning.

"Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

A correspondent writes that whilst he is an admirer of chivalry and love for one's country and countrymen, he is no less a lover of fairplay and justice of man to man. The action of a certain gentleman employed by the N. R. Company in Limon as foreman over a gang of West Indian carpenters, has been doing too much to show his love for his countrymen. Not long ago he was in the ranks with hammer and saw bearing the heat of the day, but now he is chief, and as such discharges for the most trivial offences (if any) anyone who hails not from Barbados, filling the vacancy immediately by a Barbadian.

During the past fortnight this gentleman has discharged or cause to be discharged not less than five men in seven days, his countrymen being the successors. He makes his promises beforehand and hardly two hours elapse between discharging and appointing, his choice being comparatively always on hand. He had better go slowly as his chiefs are not fools or blind men, or else he may soon have to handle his hammer and copper nails, instead of nursing piles.

Shipping News.

The s. s. "Cartago" will leave here to-day for Southampton via Port Morant, Jamaica.

The coal ship "Sollasia" left here yesterday afternoon for Cienfuegos whiere, after taking a cargo of sugar will sail for Baltimore.

Mails for the United Kingdom via Colon and Jamaica, will be closed at the Post Office to-day as follows: Ordinary letters at 1.30, registered letters at 12.30.

The "Prinz Joachim" will sail tomorrow afternoon for New York via Colon, Jamaica and Cuba, taking mails and passengers.

The United Fruit Company's steamer "Limon" arrived yesterday from Boston with the following passengers: Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Simmons, Dr. Louis J. Guier Enrique Guier, Fred. T. de Cock, Gustav de Cock. She also brought 40 tons cargo consisting of cement, cross ties and 32 sacks mails.

We learn from a reliable source that the Royal Mail Steam Packet Company will in future omit Costa Rica from their itinerary. The s. s. "Spreridge" that is expected here shortly will be the last of their boats that will call here. We understand that the change has been brought about through the lack of trade.

The s. s. "Cartago" consigned the United Fruit Company steamed into the harbour early yesterday morning from Colon, bringing several passengers for here and a good many others in transit. All the coaches were filled, as also the chair coach which was utilized by passengers that came by the "Cartago." Owing to the presence of a banana train on the line she did not leave till 10.30.

This is not the first occasion that the places of worship have been entered and electric bulbs taken, the Baptist Church lost at least fifty during the short space of two months and finally the pastor was compelled to install the are lamps in lieu of the incandescent. The stolen bulbs find a ready sale at a cheap rate in the Chinese shops and we hope some day one of the sacrilegious wretches will be caught and an example made of himself and his companion in crime—the purchaser.

Cuban Situation.

Havana.—The Governor of Cunaquey has requested President Gomez to supply him with arms and ammunition. He says that the situation is not alarming and that the resque is merely a precautionary move. The President conferred with Senor Linares, the Conservative leader of the House, regarding appropriations voted by Congress which there is no money to meet. Minister Wilson has called Washington inquiring what measures shall be taken to protect American property in case of trouble in Cuba. The leaders of the different liberal factions met and agreed to put aside differences lest intervention result. It now seems certain that Zayas will be the party's Presidential candidate.


