

We write this article with the hope that our contemporaries will read and, consider this plan, and if they approve of it they will set up a propaganda in aid of the SEARCHLIOTS plan until it be adopted, or suggest a better proposition to make our Lottery Scheme, more appreciative and enticing to its customers.
