We read in a San José paper a day or two ago copies of two letters which passed between the Presidents of Honduras and Nicaragua. The former words to the latter advising him of the capture of the "Hornet", the gun-boat of General Bouilla who leads the revolutionary party in the former Republic. This capture, the despatch says, was effected by an American cruiser welknown in these waters, the U. S. Tacoma. No particulars are yet to hand as to the why and the wherefore of this action on the part of the big. North American Republic, and we shall await them with much anxiety. There seems, however to be no doubt as to the fact that Uncle Sam maintains and intends to maintain a sort of suzerainty over the smaller Republic; and the same family. Panama Canal Tolls.

Bill providing that they vary from 50 cents to \$1.50 a Ton.

A bill proposing rates of tolls to be exacted of vessels passing through the Panama Canal was introduced in the House to-day by Representative Mann, chairman of the Committee on Interstate and foreign commerce. It is understood that in the main the measure has the approval of the President. It provides that the canal tolls shall be based on tonnage and vary from 50 cents to \$1.50 a net ton. The lower rate, under the terms of the bill, may be accorded vessels of the United States and of Panama.

There is a provision aimed at railroad companies who may seek "to avoid or reduce the effect of competition of ocean traffic between the Atlantic and Pacific coasts of the United States upon railway rates." This provision authorises the President in fixing the charges for the use of the canal to "prescribe that any vessel engaged in the coastwise trade which is owned by any railroad company or which is comed in whole or in part by any railroad company or which is controlled directly or indirectly by any railroad company or the rates of which for freight or passenger tarffic are under the direct or indirect controll of any railroad company", &c., shall pay the highest rates authorized by the bill.

Queen' Mary's patriotism in clothes

Queen Mary has not yet selected the design for her crown for the coronation. As Queen Consort a crown has to be specially made for her, as the State crown is worn by the King.

Only a certain latitude of choice is allowed the Queen. She may decide on the shape with regard to the curving of the arches and their number; that is all. The crown must consist of a circle of diamonds resting on a narrow erroine border, a cap of crimson velvet, four crosses and four diamond fleur-de-lys as in the State crown. The diamonds will be set in platinum, but the pose of the hoops can be suggested by any crown of any period the Queen prefors, wheter Hanoverian, Stuart, Tudor or Plantagenet.

In the State crown there are four arches surmounted by a cross. Queen Alexandra chose to have eight hoops, after the fashion of the crown of James I. instead of four, and the arches were not so

four, and the arches were not so raised.

The present State crown was made from jewels taken from old crowns and other ornaments at the command of Queen Victoria. It has now in addition to one large ruby one large broad shaped sapphire, sixteen sapphires, eleven emeralds, four rubes, 1,363 brilliant diamonds, 1278 rose diamonds four drop shaped, pearls and 278 pearls with the smaller of the Cullinan diamonds inset.

Queen Mary is following the example set by her mother; the Duchess of Teck, who at the time of her daughter's wedding with the present King declared that for the trousseau "not a yard of cambric or linen, of flannel or tweed, of lace or ribbon should be bought outside the kingdom', and who kept to her word. Queen Mary is having her coronation robes and gowns for court functions as well as the opening of Partiament gown made by a British firm of all material. She has ordered eight dresses so far and work on them has commenced.
