The Veto Bill THE HURRY CALL

Four day of the most uninspir-ing debate ever given to a measure involving a great constitutional reform came to a conclusion when the Premier applied clo-sure and the second reading of the Veto Bill was passed by a ma-jority of 115, the vote being 368 to 248.

Prior to this the House divided on Mr. Austin Chamberlain's amendment with a majority of 121 agains it.

The figures on the Veto Bill were greeted with prolonged cheers after which the Bill on the Premier's motion was sent to the Committee of the whole Honse. This stage is likely to be deferred for some time to enable the Gov-ernment to dispose of financial business.

The Oposition leaders are draft-ng an elaborate series of amend-

norts. Pending the Committee stage of the Bill, interest will now centre in the expected production next week of Lord Landowne's Bill, for the reform of the House of Lords. Mr. Austin Chamberlain's amend-ment, which was defeated, was mored last on behalf of the Op-vertice.
