#### A Correct Move

We are informed that the Northern Railway Company is contemplating a change in their time table between Limon and San Jose. If this rumor is true, which we have no reason to doubt, it will be hailed with pleasure by all; as it has been many times expressed by our cliteens that a change should be made in the departure of the passenger train. If the railway authorities were to despatch the passenger trains every day from Limon at seven o clock in the morning we feel confident they would be conferring a boon, and only on the citizens of Limon. but those on the lines that have to travel on the train. The change of the hour would, we believe, tend to cultact the receipts of the company, it would also to a great extent ameliorate a deal of discomfort that is now experienced by travelers.




