One of the Lower Critics Reviewed.

The ruling head of this Republic is the President. The territory over which be rules, setneds from Punta Arenas to Puerto Limon. Over that vast region dwell men of various nationalities, besides the native Coeta Ricans. In order that he might keep his subjects together and successfully govern them, it is of greatest importance that he establishes laws (orders or rules) wherewith they may be ruled. The absence of law would mean misrule, anarchy, confusion made confused, and the speedy death of the Republic. To avoid all such chaos, laws in every government is a great necessity. Thus it is clear that God's will—His Law, Paulm 40: 7. 8 is "done on earth, as it is in heaven."


