Home and Foreign News.

A Service of Song will be rendered at the Wesleyan Church on Monday evening entitled "Worship by a Song."

Meetings are being held in all the parishes of the Island of Jamaica arranging to celebrate the coronation of King George V. in right royal manner.

Up to the time of sailing of the Sarnia from Jamaica the Chief Justice did not deliver his judgment in the famous Election Petition of Cork vs. S. A. Cox.

The 24th inst. was Empire Day at Jamaica. Throughout the British West Indies and Colonies the day is observed as a day of rejoicing. Sports of various kinds were engaged in by the pleasure seekers of the Land of Spring, for which they are noted.

The gasoline launch Alva arrived here yesterday from Bluefield and left in the evening for Bocas del Toro. She brought several passengers. One of the passengers in conversation with our representative said that laborers are required there to work in the lagoons. Liberal price is paid for contract work.

The men J. Washington, Sterling and C. G. Ferguson did not leave Limon for Limon's good on Friday night last on the "Cartago" for Barrios as was expected, they are still here rousing their chance. What the issues will be we know not; but there is an old adage that runs thus: "The wheels of justice runs slow but sure."

A great sensation was created among the clerks in two Government departments at Jamaica, as the results of a circular issued by the heads of the departments to the clerks. The heads of departments affected have issued a circular which seeks to obtain from the clerks information whether or not they are in the hands of money lenders; if so the names of the lenders and the extent to which they are indebted. It would be well if such an investigation be ordered here, when we fear much would be disclosed.

The Lucas Cricket Club scored a glorious victory over Kensington C. C. in a cup match. The Lucas went to the wicket first and put up the magnificent score of 239 runs for the loss of one wicket. J. K. Holt, not out, 173; C. Small, 25; S. Uter, not out, 24. The Kensington were all out for 75 runs; the men getting into double figures were G. C. Foster, who knocked up 22; L. J. There was a bye-election in Kingston, Jamaica, to fill the seat in the City Council made vacant through the resignation of the Hon. H. A. L. Simpson. The two principals were Hon. S. A. G. Cox and Mr. Barnes Alves. Finally at 8 a.m., on 22nd inst. the Returning Officer declared the poll open. The polling of votes were brisk throughout the day. The colors of both men were red and green. Mrs. Cox was busy throughout the day distributing rosettes to those that were in favour of her husband. She stood

in the Mayor and Council's Office and with the assistance of another lady turned out several rosettes. Mr. Alves objected to it as it had undue influence over him. The Returning Officer upheld his objection and the ladies were politely asked to leave the office. The polling was closed at five o'clock and an hour after the result was declared, which showed that Mr. Cox had vanquished his opponent. The voting stood as follows: Cox 535, Bain Alves 131. Majority for Cox—404.

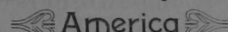

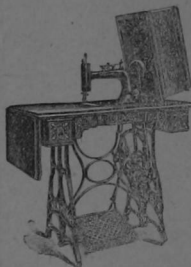

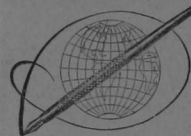
