PERIL OF YELLOW FEVER.

THE OUTSTANDING FEA-TURES OF A NEW BOOK BY SIR RUBERT W. BOYCE.

In his "Mosquito or Man," published two years ago. Sir Rubert W. Boyce gave a succinct account in simple unterbried language of the various mosquito-borne diseases. In a new volume just issued he presents the problem of one of these diseases, yello x fever, and indicates the means of its prevention. Though written primarily as a manual for young medical men taking up work in the Tropies, the exposition is so heald and the illustrations so autoerous that no layman need hold aloof. Be it remembered that tropical medicine owes an incalculable debt to the insight of two distinguished laymen, Mr. Joseph Chamoerlain and Sir Affred Johnson. Sir Rupert's credentials for the task are the highest not only is he aman of first-rate scientific calibre, but he has also minatched experience of the disease at closs quarters in New Orleans, in British Hondurus and Central America, in the West Indies and British Guiana, and finally in West Africa during the outbreak in 1910. What is the main thesis of the book? It is this: that the deadly reputation of West Africa, which in the past has made it the white main's grave, has at last been traced with scientific precision to its cause: that that cause is yellow fever, and that we have in our hands weapons for its annibitation, if we will use them.

of the late American Commission, several of whom submitted to experimental infection, either by the bite of the Stegomyia or by the inocalation of blood from a yellowfever patient, finally put the whole question on a scientific focting. They showed that after infection an incubation period of some six days elapsed before the appearance of definite symptoms; that during the first three days of illness the patient's blood contained the virus and was able to infect a Stegomyia; and that after an incubation period of twelve days this Stegomyia could convey the disease afresh to a susceptible subject. This cycle of events is clear to demonstration. From a study of the history and geographical distribution of yellow fever, Sir Rubert concludes that in all-probability the primary endemic focus of the disease was in Gentral America, South America and the West Inease was in Central America.
