Larger profits Shown.

Boston, May 18.—With the advent of May, net profits of the United Fruit Company from its fruit department, have shown a material betterment and prices which at one time were 12 per cent to 15 per cent below the corresponding date of the previous fiscal year, now have advanced to a point where the company is getting as much for its fruit as in May a year ago. This fact, together with some increase in importations, has increased net fruit earnings for the last few weeks 20 per cent to 30 per cent above those for the same weeks of 1911.

United Fruit Company has to date imported only a trifle over 1 per cent more bananas than during the same seven and one-half months of the fiscal year ended September 30 last. When the season started the management rather expected an increase in importations for the year of a full 10 per cent. Now it will be satisfied with less than 5 per cent.

The United Fruit Company will this fiscal period put into cultivation a total of over 8000 acres of banana lands in various tropical divisions. This

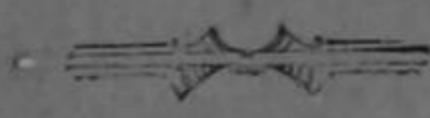

PUBLIC INTEREST.

Limon seemed wearied of two items which are constantly being thrown on the ears of our readers, but considering the importance of both these items we feel we cannot but allude again and again to them as the different phases of the arguments arise.

The items are the protectorship of immigrants, and the banana controversy, the former vitally interesting to a certain class of this community, that is the Jamaica Colony, although we see a very praiseworthy article from the pen of the Rev. E. A. Pitt to the "Trinidad Mirror" calling on the other West Indian Islands to subscribe and cooperate with the Jamaican Government making it a West Indian Protectorship in view of recent occurrences; the latter, not alone to the banana growers but to the entire country.

In another column is an advertisement from the Atlantic notifying the public that they will start purchasing fruit on the 14th inst. This seems very interesting to the public, but there are those who are questioning what responsibility does the Atlantic guarantee to the growers that they will continue buying fruit in the country so as not to eliminate the possibility of being left to the mercy of the United Fruit Company in the event of their withdrawal from activities here. We have felt it our duty to interest ourselves considerably in this matter, being of such weighty importance to the public at large, and we are informed by responsible parties, that the Atlantic Fruit Company will start within a couple weeks investing 100,000 dollars gold in planting their own farms, as well as, it is their intention to buy in several farms that may be convenient to the different waterways. This therefore being correct, does away with the idea that they are not responsible enough that our people should enter into negotiations with this company for the delivery of fruit. We are proud that this should be so because we need competition in the country, it is therefore in the interest not only of the banana growers but to every labourer clerk and artisan in the country to help to keep the competition up with the presence of the Atlantic Company. This is the only chance that Costa Rica will have of seeing competition in the country, and if those people who are in a position to help to keep this new company here does not do all in their power for this end, they may yet have to feel that they have committed a suicidal act in helping to strangle a laudable effort.

We would like to suggest to the owners of fruit to do as the people in Jamaica have done, that is to keep on the side of the Atlantic for all it is worth.

We know that offers will be made by the existing company to cope with the rates offered by the new company and possibly higher, so as to get them out of the way, but wait until the contracts which are now being signed have expired and the chance of competition has been lost and you will see that the price of fruit will drop possibly to 25 cents, we may be told plainly that your fruit is not wanted except you can take what we offer you.

The small farmers now say that Mr. Laws on behalf of the U. F. Company has been offering them contracts which has hitherto been denied them and also to take at certain seasons six hands bananas and to give them lands free to cultivate, at the same time threatening not to take their fruit when the Atlantic does go if she has to go, this alone is proof of our arguments, and no offers should be rashly accepted, but on the contrary every consideration taken for keeping up the competition by fostering any new comer whether it be the Lindo Fruit Company, Atlantic Fruit Company or any other but encourage competition even if you have to give the new comer your fruit at a trifle less than the offers of the other, as you know the consequence after you have rejected that competition.

Largest Steamship Company.

A check for the enormous sum of 25,867,863 dollars drawn by the Royal Mail Steam Packet Company in favour of the Union Castle Company complete the purchase of the latter line by the former and makes the Royal Mail the largest steamship concern in the world. The final payment was made in London on April 27th. With the acquisition of the Union Castle Line the Royal Mail now owns either outright or a majority of stock in six great steamship companies with a total tonnage of 1,389,570. Its nearest competitor, in the matter of tonnage is the Hamburg American with a total of 1,210,000. The lines operated include services from England and the United States to Bermuda, Cuba, Jamaica, Panama, Columbia, Venezuela, the Windward Islands, Brazil, Argentina, Uruguay, Chile, Peru, West Coast of Africa, South and East Africa, China and Japan.

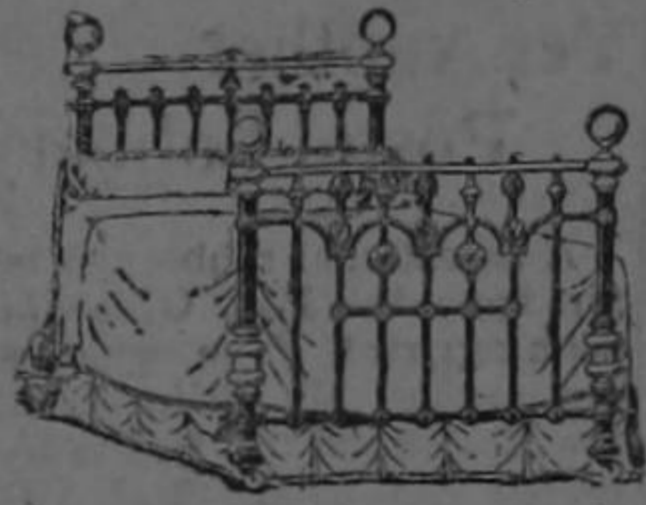

PREJUDICE TRIES TO SWAY THE GOVERNOR.—We have no doubt that there are some Americans resident in these countries, (not of the best) who might kick like blazes at the idea of a colored man coming as Protector. Steamer Ashore

The Leyland Line steamer Antillian is reported on the rocks at Turke Island. The ship hit the reef at East Point on her way to Jamaica on Thursday last. The wrecking steamer Premier has gone to her assistance.

Guatemala Railroad.

The Guatemala Central Railroad, which is approximately 225 miles long and extends from San Jose on the Pacific to the City of Guatemala has been acquired by Mr. Minor Keith. The United Fruit Company will shortly establish a direct service between New York and Puerto Barrios on the Atlantic coast, which also has rail communication with Guatemala City.

It is reported that the purchasers intend to complete a fourteen mile gap in order to connect with the Pan-American road and with Mexican lines

Yet Another Postal Robbery

A sensational robbery of letters from the Post Office has been reported. From what we can gather, Mr. Selim Castro the Postmaster of Limon suspected the chief clerk (who acts for him in his absence) Santiago Bolaños and through a small hole made for the purpose in the partition between the registered department and another, observed that Bolaños was stealing from money letters. He immediately communicated the fact to San Jose and was ordered to come to the capital for the purpose of making a personal report on the matter—no word was said about the arrest of the suspected clerk in the telegraphic order. Mr. Castro considering that it was dangerous to leave Bolaños in charge of the registered branch after the evidence of the man's dishonesty which he had; appointed another clerk in the department to take his place, the heads of the department at the capital however, objected to it and ordered that Bolaños be replaced in charge as he was the next in position to the postmaster, with the inevitable result that while Mr. Castro was in San Jose, Bolaños cleared the safe completely out of all registered mail matter and cash for the sale of stamps took passage on the Cartago for Colon on Wednesday night last and got safely away from Costa Rica.

It is difficult to make a guess as to the number of letters or their gross value that the scoundrel has got away. Who is responsible? If Castro had been ordered to arrest the thief when he reported that he saw him abstracting the money from letters, the safe would not have been robbed of its contents and the public not have been victimized, then again if Mr. Castro's precaution for which we commend him had been respected when he placed another clerk in charge of the department the final robbery would not have taken place. In our last issue we called attention to the frequency of robberies from registered letters and within twenty four hours we are confronted with this wholesale robbery of mails deposited with the Government for despatch to foreign countries.

This matter needs the most searching enquiry and as the guilty party has escaped through the carelessness of some one in authority, the responsibility should be placed on the right party.

Sir,—Please allow me space in your valuable paper to put this before the public. The people who are living around this vicinity (chiefly Jamaicans) are being disturbed by a so called Italian Governor named Pearan here, who took upon himself to charge the people rent for living on the Coy's property which is contrary to the arrangement agreed to by the U. F. Company in Jamaica. It seems as if some of the mandadors without permission from the company are leasing the company's land, and hence the trouble. Some of these people are living here upwards of ten years, and never been interrupted by the company until this Italian governor awakes from his slumber. The people are prepared not to pay any rent, but will willingly give up possession of their houses, if they be legally paid by who ever wants to dispossess them. 'Tis true that the company provides camps for the labourers; but there are good many respectable men with their wives and children, who can't live in camps, and if they try to live peaceably and decently in the country, why should they be molested by other foreigners, and not by the company or natives?

These are just the things that stir up the people's anger and cause great criminal cases in the country. The people are told that few days from this date, they will have to leave their houses, which will cause trouble. We therefore sincerely ask the Government and those in authority to give some advise today the Italian governor brought in the Alcalde from Siquirres to embargo the people's houses, one man is now in jail on this account.

quainted than he—with his Old Line farms, of the fact that not 50 per cent of the banana producers can get a fair interest on their investment by selling to the United Fruit Company at 14½ cents for an eight hand bunch. He concludes his circular by stating that "if you wish for a contract a line to me will get you the same kind of contract as I have."

I think many people who hold contracts at present would be glad of this. Does the contract he has been holding call for no more than one cutting a week, and not full fruit only? If it did and has been enforced as it has been with many growers, I might inform Mr. Lindo that he would have delivered approximately 20 per cent less fruit than he has done in the past.

I hold no brief for the Atlantic Fruit Company and emphatically disapprove of their present methods. The only way they can get in here is to open up new land, lay new spurs and to put it vulgarly, show us the colour of their money.

It is however, certainly up to growers (with or without contracts) who are selling their fruit for 30 cents a first and 14½ a second, to amalgamate and form plans for the future. Then if the Atlantic Fruit Co. wish to take up their cause in a sensible and business manner let them do so. If they will not others will, because there is money in it.

I consider that an Association of Growers not directly connected with the U. Fruit Co. should at once be formed a meeting called and the matter thoroughly discussed.

I think it will be interesting to all to know the views of people on this matter, who own or represent those who own over 50 hectares of land cultivated in banana

EL SEGURO SOCIAL SUIZO.—El pueblo suizo ratificó por 50,000 votos de mayoría, en un *ad referendum*, la ley de seguros sociales expedida por el Congreso federal, el año pasado. Se compone de dos partes: la primera, que no fué seriamente combatida, consagra el seguro en caso de enfermedad, y es una simple ley de subvención que regula las condiciones que deben llenar las Cajas de seguros mutuos para obtener subsidios de los poderes públicos. La segunda parte trata del seguro contra los accidentes del trabajo é instituye una Caja nacional en que deberán asegurarse obligatoriamente todos los patronos que hoy están sometidos al régimen de la responsabilidad civil. Los patronos se opusieron, á causa de las cotizaciones á que quedaban sujetos; la extensión de la responsabilidad á los accidentes no profesionales, les permitió asentar su resistencia, apoyándose en el peligro de la simulación; finalmente invocaron un tercer motivo de queja: el temor de que los recursos actuales de la Confederación no basten para cubrir los compromisos que la ley impone á su Tesoro y que montan ocho ó nueve millones de francos por año.

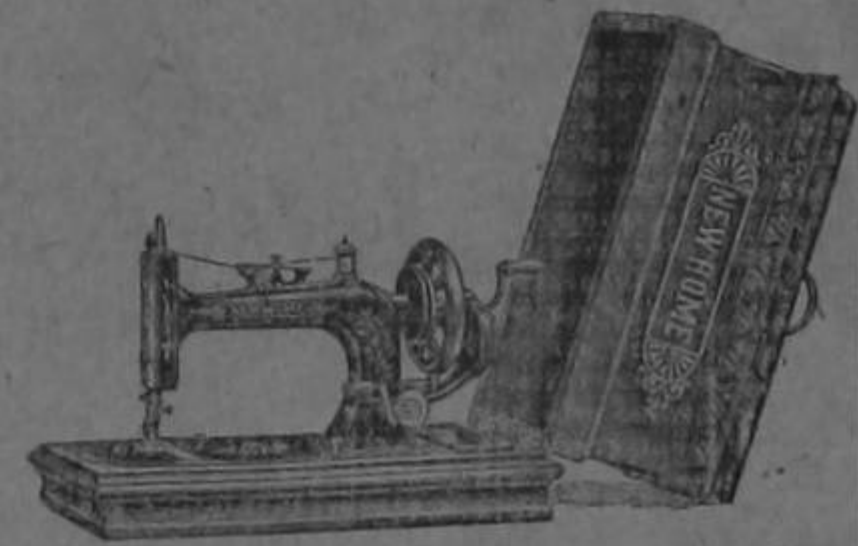

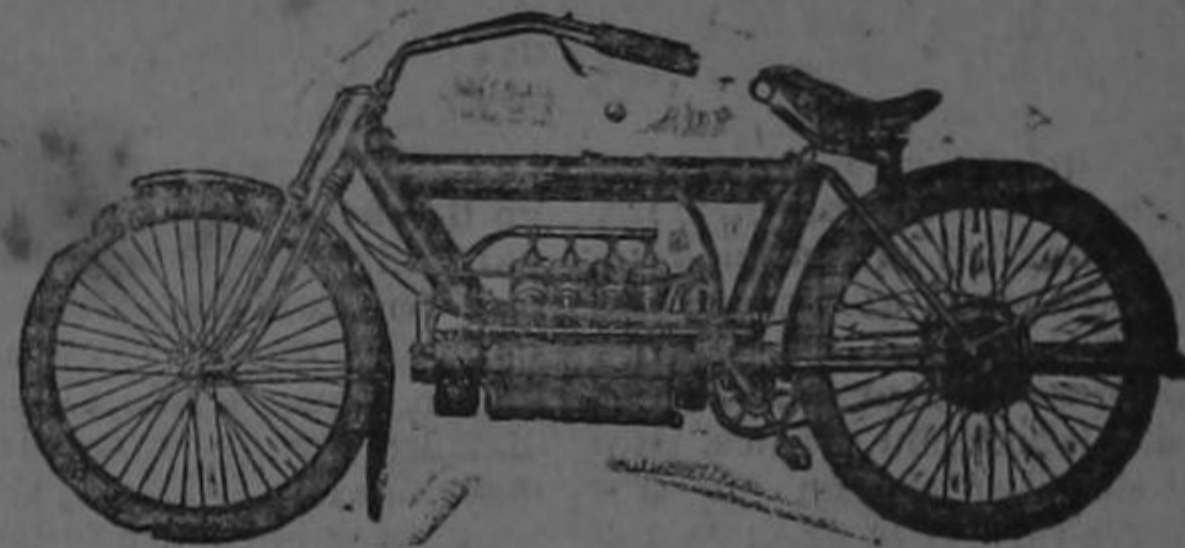
