The Recent Earthquake.

The earthquake of the 6th which was barely felt here appears to have wrought considerable damage in the interior. The villages of Sarchi and Toro Amarillo suffered greatly. Several houses were carried away by the river which rose 24 meters within a few minutes after the shock, nine persons have been known to be missing from the former village while a Sr. Castro lost his wife and child as well as all his property at Toro Amarillo.

The President visited the stricken districts almost immediately after and promise the people help. Fifty thousand colones has been voted by Congress to help the sufferers and lumber, zinc, and food is being rushed to the two stricken districts. Professor Biolley visited the district and on reaching the foot of the volcano Poas, was greeted with an earthquake shock of much intensity, and was followed by no less than one hundred shocks within an hour. The intensity of these varying from III to VII, huge rents are visible on the sides of the mountains from top to base, and it is estimated that at least 300 manzanas of land slid down from the W. N. W. side of the volcano to the river. From Tres Rios comes the news that a heavy fall of snow followed by a deluge of rain took place, the people were panic stricken, the river banks were piled up with snow and the coffee plantations and pastures completely covered by the snow fall. The coffee and other crops are it is feared completely ruined.

El alma nueva de Francia

Interrogado por un reportero, un moralista eminente ha declarado hoy mismo:

—Los alemanes, los ingleses, los americanos, todos los pueblos, en suma, se figuran que en nuestra patria no existe la vida de familia. Acabo justamente de leer una revista yanqui y veo que un viajero habla de París como un baile público. Los extranjeros calumnian nuestras costumbres y hacen creer que entre nosotros no hay más que cán-cán, cortesanas, actrices ligeras e intrigas galantes, lo que es falso y absurdó.

El moralista que habla de ese modo, tiene razón. Pero yo creo que si los extranjeros presentan así á París, es porque los parisenses les enseñan el camino. Un caso reciente lo prueba. Queriendo testear a una comisión oficial inglesa, organizaron los ediles de Niza una representación teatral. ¿Y sabéis lo que dijeron? Pues nada menos que "Cabotín," de Tristan Bernard. Yo á decir verdad, no conozco esa pieza, pero en un estudio del teatro del gran autor contemporáneo, encuentro un análisis de ella que me hace ver su fallo. Al levantarse el telón—dice este análisis—nos encontramos entre actrices gorgorantes y vaporosas. La gente de teatro está tan en auge, que cuando un dramaturgo quiere basar sus personajes simpáticos, recurre á las damas jóvenes enamoradas y á los galanes celosos.... La dama joven de "Cabotín" no está enamorada. Está casada. Después de una larga y brillante "carreira" encuentra, en efecto, á un príncipe ruso" el gran Kolbasof, que le da su nombre y su fortuna. Juntos se van á vivir á Petersburgo, en donde la rubia Marietta representa con un talento admirable su papel de princesa. Pero ¡ay! en medio de todos sus triunfos sociales, la muchacha de Nougautes no puede dejar de suspirar por la vida de teatro, por los aplausos, por los ataques de nervios, por las aventuras en los pasillos que llevan á jazmín y á aguas sucias. Un día pasea una "troupe" por Rusia. El empresario es amigo de Marietta. Se ven. Ella le dice que quiere ir á París, á representar algún papel durante unos cuantos días. Se arregla todo. Y pretextando la necesidad de ir á cuidar á su pobre madre enferma, la rubia dama abandona á su noble esposo.

Ya en París, Marietta ensaya su papel y se siente más felicidad que nunca. El día de su debut llega. Son las seis de la tarde. De pronto, alguien llama á la puerta: "El empresario?".... No; el mariado. ¡Santos cielos! Y lo curioso es que llega comiendo, parlero, ignorante de todo.

—Al llegar á la estación —dice— vi pasar al Presidente de la República y le grité: "Viva este noble país!"

—En francés?

—No..., en ruso....

Marietta encuentra en el acto el medio de deshacerse de su señor esposo. Corre á buscar á un comiso amigo suyo y le dice:

—Vístete de comisario de policía y ven á casa. Vas á decir al príncipe que sus palabras son consideradas como un insulto al Jefe del Estado, por lo el Ministro ha dado un decreto expulsándolo de Francia.

Así lo hace el actor y Kolbasof lo cree.

Pero antes quiere pasar por el teatro de Nougautes para ver á una amiga suya á quien conoció en San Petersburgo. En vez de su amiga, aparece su mujer. Gran escándalo. Luego gran explicación. Al fin gran reconciliación.

Tal es la comedia escogida por los provinciales, ¿es inmoral? No, no lo es. Pero hay en ella el eterno medio ambiente cocoteo, de risa y de engaño, que hace creer que en Francia todo es una orgía perpetua, una perpetua burla, y de seguro los ingleses, después de asistir á la función que su honor de ellos se daba, dijeron:

—Tienen razón los que nos hablan de la frivolidad de este pueblo. La existencia que se refleja en su literatura y en su teatro es una ligereza casi parana. La idea de familia no aparece por ninguna parte. Las mujeres libres son las únicas cuyas historias preocupan á los dramaturgos. Jamás vemos

en las novelas una escena como las de nuestros Dickens. Todo es amor perverso, todo es intriga, todo es fiesta. El alma de Rastignac y el alma de la Torpille son siempre las que dominan.

Esto, para el que sólo conoce la vida francesa por las novelas, por las comedias, por las crónicas de los tribunales, por los ecos inundados de los periódicos, es una verdad evidente. Y sin embargo, si hay en el mundo un país cuyo fondo sea estructuralmente serio y familiar, es Francia. Porque Francia no es París, como París no es Montmartre. Francia es esa vasta y bella provincia en donde las casas de modesto aspecto encierran la vida burguesa tal cual existía en tiempo de Ronsard; Francia es ese admirable campo que se extiende desde las playas de la Mancha hasta los Pirineos y en la cual cada familia tiene una huerta; Francia es esa formidable región fabril en donde las ciudades negras de carbón y vibrantes de energías son como columnas humanas; Francia es esa tierra de los experimentos peligrosos en la cual se fabrican los primeros automóviles y los primeros zeppelin; Francia es esa cuna fecunda de hombres activos que dan al África actual conquistadores dignos de figurar en la historia al lado de los Víctorias y de los Alvarados....

Sólo qué, claro, esa Francia real interesa al mundo menos que las de las comedias, como la Española verdadera interesa menos que la de pandereta.

■■■ En ésto, digáse lo que se quiera, no son los extranjeros los culpables. Los extranjeros creen lo que cada país dice de sí mismo. España se empeña en que sus pintores hagan cuadros de brujas, como los de Zuluaga, que sus novelistas cuentan historias de bandidos como Baeza Ibañez, que sus dramaturgos expongan escenas de cromo como los de Quintero.... Pues entonces no hay qué quejarse de que Europa ve la imagen de la nación española en una mano con un mantón de manita bailando un tango en un tinglado sucio, ente contrabandistas de tabaco. Francia quiere que sus novelistas no describan más que

adulterios mundanos con muchas quintasencias pecaminosas, y que sus dramaturgos no expongan sino la existencia de las actrices vaporosas, y que sus pintores no pinten sino mujeres que suspiran entre los brazos de galanes de frac? Pues que no proteste en ese caso cuando los de fuera simbolizan su imagen en un cocote que baila un can-can desordenado entre bedores de champaña.

—Los ingleses,—dice todo el mundo—son los seres más hipócritas del orbe, pues teniendo muchos vicios y muchos defectos, no dejan traslucir sino sus virtudes y sus buenas cualidades.

Cierto, muy cierto. Pero tal vez en lugar de seguir protestando contra tal hipocresía, fuera bueno hacer lo posible por imitarla. En Francia y en España, sobre todo, un poco de más respeto de sí mismo estaría bien. De lo contrario, dentro de diez años, ya no habrá nadie en el mundo que no crea que todo España es una plaza de toros y toda Francia un café concierto.







The Recent Earthquake.

The earthquake of the 6th which was barely felt here appears to have wrought considerable damage in the interior. The villages of Sarchi and Toro Amarillo suffered greatly. Several houses were carried away by the river which rose 24 metros within a few minutes after the shock, nine persons have been known to be missing from the former village while a Sr. Castro lost his wife and child as well as all his property at Toro Amarillo.

The President visited the stricken districts almost immediately after and promised the people help. Fifty thousand colones has been voted by Congress to help the sufferers and lumber, zinc, and food is being rushed to the two stricken districts. Professor Biolley visited the district and on reaching the foot of the volcano Poas, was greeted with an earthquake shock of much intensity, and was followed by no less than one hundred shocks within an hour. The intensity of these varying from III to VII, huge rents are visible on the sides of the mountains from top to base, and it is estimated that at least 300 manzanas of land slid down from the W. N. W. side of the volcano to the river. From Tres Rios comes the news that a heavy fall of snow followed by a deluge of rain took place, the people were panic stricken, the river banks were piled up with snow and the coffee plantations and pastures completely covered by the snow fall. The coffee and other crops are it is feared completely ruined.

Bahyo Gone. This beats Richmond

He took ill some weeks ago and died on Tuesday in the Hospital. Many people will miss the little fellow and feel sorry that Limon has lost one of her curiosities.

The loud laugh of the men and the sudden collapse of the foreman so exasperated him that he immediately reported the matter to his friend the Superintendent. We regret that the Superintendent's reply is not recorded on the gramophone which the washerwoman won and didn't get.



Sir.—Please allow me space in your valuable paper to put this before the public. The people who are living around this vicinity (chiefly Jamaicans) are being disturbed by a so called Italian Governor named Pearan here, who took upon himself to charge the people rent for living on the Coy's property which is contrary to the arrangement agreed to by the U. F. Company in Jamaica. It seems as if some of the landlords without permission from the company are leasing the company's land, and hence the trouble. Some of these people are living here upwards of ten years, and never been interrupted by the company until this Italian governor awakes from his slumber. The people are prepared not to pay any rent, but will willingly give up possession of their houses, if they be legally paid by who ever wants to dispossess them.

'Tis true that the company provides camps for the labourers; but there are good many respectable men with their wives and children, who can't live in camps, and if they try to live peaceably and decently in the country, why should they be molested by other foreigners, and not by the company or natives?

These are just the things that stir up the people's anger and cause great criminal cases in the country. The people are told that few days from this date, they will have to leave their homes, which will cause trouble. We therefore sincerely ask the Government and those in authority to give some advise today the Italian governor brought in the Alcalde from Siquirres to embargo the people's houses, one man is now in jail on this account.

quainted than he—with his Old Line farms, of the fact that not 50 per cent of the banana producers can get a fair interest on their investment by selling to the United Fruit Company at 14½ cents for an eight hand bunch. He concludes his circular by stating that "if you wish for a contract a line to me will get you the same kind of contract as I have."

I think many people who hold contracts at present would be glad of this. Does the contract he has been holding call for more than one cutting a week, and that full fruit only? If it did and has been enforced as it has been with many growers, I might inform Mr. Lindo that he would have delivered approximately 20 per cent less fruit than he has done in the past.

I hold no brief for the Atlantic Fruit Company and emphatically disapprove of their present methods. The only way they can get in here is to open up new land, lay new spurs and to put it vulgarly, show us the colour of their money.

It is however, certainly up to growers (with or without contracts) who are selling their fruit for 30 cents a first and 14½ a second, to amalgamate and form plans for the future. Then if the Atlantic Fruit Co. wish to take up their cause in a sensible and business manner let them do so. If they will not others will, because there is money in it.

I consider that an Association of Growers not directly connected with the U. Fruit Co. should at once be formed a meeting called and the matter thoroughly discussed.

I think it will be interesting to all to know the views of people on this matter, who own or represent those who own over 50 hectareas of land cultivated in banana

El alma nueva de Francia

Interrogado por un reportero, un moralista ha declarado hoy mismo:

- Los alemanes, los ingleses, los americanos, todos los pueblos, en su mayoría, se figuran que en nuestra patria no existe la vida de familia. Acabo justamente de leer una revista yanqui y veo que un viajero habla de Paris como un baile público. Los extranjeros calumnian nuestras costumbres y hacen creer que entre nosotros no hay más que can-can, cortesanas, actrices ligeras e intrigas galantes, lo que es falso y absurdo.

El moralista que habla de ese modo, tiene razón. Pero yo creo que si los extranjeros presentan así á Paris, es porque los parisienes les enseñan el camino. Un caso reciente lo prueba. Queriendo festejar á una comisión oficial inglesa, organizaron los ediles de Niza una representación teatral. ¿Y sabéis lo que dijeron? Pues nada menos que "Cabotin," de Tristán Bernard. Yo á decir verdad, no conozco esta pieza, pero en un estudio del teatro del gran autor contemporáneo, encuentro un análisis de ella que me hace ver su índole. Al levantarse el telón-dice este análisis-nos encontramos entre actrices gorgorantes y vaporosas. La gente de teatro está tan en auge, que cuando un dramaturgo quiere buscar personajes simpáticos, recurre á las damas jóvenes enamoradas y á los galanes celosos, ... La dama joven de "Cabotin" no está enamorada. Está casada. Después de una larga y brillante carrera encuentra, en efecto, á un príncipe ruso" el gran Kolbasof, que le da su nombre y su fortuna. Juntos se van á vivir á Petersburgo, en donde la rubia Marieta representa con un talento admirable su papel de princesa. Pero ¡hay! en medio de todos sus triunfos sociales, la muchacha de Nouveautés no puede dejar de suspirar por la vida de teatro, por los aplausos, por los ataques de nervios, por las aventuras en los pasillos que llevan á jazmín y á aguas sucias. Un día pasea una "troupe" por Rusia. El empresario es amigo de Marietta. Se ve. Ella le dice que quiere ir á Paris, á representar algún papel durante unos cuantos días. Se arregla todo. Y pretextando la necesidad de ir á cuidar á su pobre madre enferma, la rubia dama abandona á su noble esposo.

Ya en Paris, Marieta ensaya su papel y se siente más feliz que nunca. El día de su debut llega. Son las seis de la tarde. De pronto, alguien llama á la puerta ¿El empresario?... No; el marido. ¡Santos cielos! Y lo curioso es que llega contento, parlante, ignorante de todo.

- Al llegar á la estación -dice- vi pasar al Presidente de la República y le grité: ¡Viva este noble país!

- En francés?

- No... en ruso...

Marieta encuentra en el acto el medio de deshacerse de su señor esposo. Corre á buscar á un cómico amigo suyo y le dice:

- Vistete de comisario de policía y ven á casa. Vas á decir al príncipe que sus palabras son consideradas como un insulto al Jefe del Estado, por lo el Ministro ha dado un decreto expulsándolo de Francia.

Así lo hizo el actor y Kolbasof lo creyó.

Pero antes quiere pasar por el teatro de Nouveautés para ver á una amiga suya á quien conoció en San Petersburgo. En vez de su amiga, aparece su mujer. Gran escándalo. Luego gran explicación. Al fin gran reconciliación.

Tal es la comedia escogida por los provincianos. ¿Es immoral? No, no lo es. Pero hay en ella el eterno medio ambiente cocoteo, de risa y de engaño, que hace creer que en Francia todo es una orgía perpetua, una perpetua burla, y de seguro los ingleses, después de asistir á la función que su honor de chosse daba, dijeronse:

- Tienen razón los que nos hablan de la frivolidad de este pueblo. La existencia que se refleja en su literatura y en su teatro es una ligereza casi pagana. La idea de familia no aparece por ninguna parte. Las mujeres libres son las únicas cuyas historias ocupan á los dramaturgos. Jamás venimos

en las novelas una escena como las de nuestros Dickens. Todo es amor perverso, todo es intriga, todo es fiesta. El alma de Rascignac y el alma de la Torpille son siempre las que dominan.

Este, para el que sólo conoce la vida francesa por las novelas, por las comedias, por las crónicas de los tribunales, por los ecos mundanos de los periódicos, es una verdad evidente. Y sin embargo, si hay en el mundo un país cuyo fondo sea estrictamente serio y familiar, es Francia. Porque Francia no es París, como París no es Montmartre. Francia es esa vasta y bella provincia en donde las casas de modesto aspecto encierran la vida burguesa tal cual existía en tiempo de Ronsard; Francia es ese admirable campo que se extiende desde las playas de la Mancha hasta los Pirineos y en la cual cada familia tiene una huerta; Francia es esa formidable región fabril en donde las ciudades negras de carbón y vibrantes de energías son como columnas humanas; Francia es esa tierra de los experimentos peligrosos en la cual se fabrican los primeros automóviles y los primeros aviones; Francia es esa cuna fecunda de hombres activos que da al África actual conquistadores dignos de figurar en la historia al lado de los Valdivia y de los Alvarado.

Sólo que, claro, esa Francia real interesa al mundo menos que las de las comedias, como la España verdadera interesa menos que la de pantomima.

Y en ésto, digáse lo que se quiera, no son los extranjeros los culpables. Los extranjeros creen lo que cada país dice de sí mismo. España se empeña en que sus pintores usen cuadros de brujas, como los de Zuluaga, que sus novelistas cuenten historias de bandoleros como Barco Ibañez, que sus dramaturgos expongan escenas de cromó como los de Quintero.... Pues entonces no hay que quejarse de que Europa ve la imagen de la nación española en una manola con un mantón de manila bailando un tango en un tinglado sucio, ente contrabandistas de tabaco. Francia quiere que sus novelistas no describan más que

ajedrez mundano con muchas quintas y escenas pecaminosas, y que sus dramaturgos no expongan sino la existencia de las actrices vaporosas, y que sus pintores no pinten sino mujeres que suspiran entre los brazos de galanes de frac? Pues que no proteste en ese caso cuando los de fuera simbolizan su imagen en un cocote que baila un cán cán desordenado entre bebedores de champán.

- Los ingleses, -dice todo el mundo- son los seres más hipócritas del orbe, pues teniendo muchos vicios y muchos defectos, no dejan traslucir sino sus virtudes y sus buenas cualidades.

Cierto, muy cierto. Pero tal vez en lugar de seguir protestando contra tal hipocresía, faera bueno hacer lo posible por imitarla. En Francia y en España, sobre todo, un poco de más respeto de sí mismo estaría bien. De lo contrario, dentro de diez años, ya no habrá nadie en el mundo que no crea que todo España es una plaza de toros y toda Francia un café concierto.

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
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
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
