ATLANTIC'S FIRST LOAD

At the sound of the whistle of the Hamburg American Steamship Prinz Joachim on Sunday last, we were forced to recall the fact that this was the signal fact that this was the signal for the realization of an accomplishment that must long be remembered by every resident in the town who cherishes a hope for the betterment of Costa Rica.

Too much has been said and done to need any comment, but we cannot pass on without reflecting on the able manner Mr. R. C. Wetmore, Manager of the Atlantic Fruit Coy. here, conducted his business all through the fight, while other heads were busy along the lines, walking armed, driving in specials, running pell-mell in gasoline cars. He kept a perfectly level head directing his operations by telegrams and messages as he had no cars nor specials in a manner that even his opposers could not but admire and fear. His seriousness and gentlemanly deportment while his opponents were doing everything to frustrate his plans for securing a preliminary cargo, was keenly regarded by the public. His admirers felt that a demonstration should have been given at the departure of the ship, but on reflection it was decided that the time had not yet arrived for public display, in consequence of the various matters under consideration. However we are proud that the first shipment has been made, every man woman and child ought to be glad and the mercantile section of Costa Rica ought to assist the small planters to see to the future, for we have got to recollect that now that the fight has begun we cannot look back or we shall be oppressed in a manner that would make our existence in Costa Rica impossible. There are those who think that the Atlantic Fruit Coy. is only endeavouring to ship a few bunches so as to create sympathy with the public to help them to win the case, how absurd, how ridiculous to think that because this company buys a few stems of fruit in the country this could influence the justice of the country? And supposing that they won or lost the case could a responsible company after entering into the Commercial life of a country and win the esteem and sympathy of the entire country possibly be so dishonourable as to suddenly quit their operations in that country? echo answers no. To us there is no lawsuit over the farms for it would appear that the lawsuit is only to decide a question of privileges, but as far as the farms are concerned that seem to be in their hands to deposit the money and guarantees as decided upon when the time expires and take your farms. Therefore there is no reason

why they should leave the country backed as they are by public opinion and the banana growers of the country, for if there is a farmer in the country small or great who does not glory in the advent of the Atlantic Fruit Coy. we are yet to hear of him.

Series of Fracas.

On Monday we learn that there was a rather amusing scrap at Siquirres. A Banana Receiver whose name we did not obtain, got at loggerheads with a labourer. It is said that the labourer asked for rations as is customary, but he came in at a late hour which the Receiver reminded him of, hot words followed and the Receiver kicked him, with the result that the entire gang fell on the Receiver and would have killed him had other people not intervened.

ANOTHER.

There was also a fracas on Monday last at the Aduna, when Don Manuel Lopez was accosted by a labourer who seemed to have been drunk. After this he tried his game with our friend Don Tomas, but seeing the disadvantages, the poor fellow was under, Don Manuel simply pushed him out the way, rather than illtreating him. The man was taken away by friends of his, as they felt he would not have been so rude had he not been drunk.

A couple days ago, the foreman car repairer came in for some harsh treatment at the hands of switchman Lawrence. It appears that Mr. Forst told the man to take away a car which he refused to do on the ground that Forst had no right to give him orders, this latter abused the man who returned it and went on to the Pier on his duty. He was followed there by Forst who accosted him on the Pier, resulting that Lawrence is said to have given him a whipping.

After walking from the Northern to the Pier to seek a fight, this is hard luck.

Another Company Grand Excursion Day

With reference to the entry of another Banana Company to which we made reference last week, we find "La Republica" also mentions the same thing in Tuesday's issue.

It says that the Spanish Transatlantic Steamship Coy. will open up stations here for shipping fruit to Barcelona and other European ports, independent of the United Fruit or the Atlantic Fruit Companies.

We have made enquiries and find that there is a Mr. Carro from that Company here, and that the measurements of the loading machine, and distance between and name of stations along the Railway lines have all been sent to Europe for consideration.

Chasing a Villain

We are pleased to see that Mr. Abraham Mendez has returned from New Orleans whither he had to go in consequence of having to go after J. Broderick, a lottery ticket seller of his, who absconded with 600 colones in tickets for that gentleman. The fact of his boarding the steamer for Puerto Barrios was reported to Mr. Mendez, but when he searched the ship he could not find Broderick, he then decided to go to Barrios with the man, but on the way Broderick came from his hiding place and confessed to Mr Mendez begging his forgiveness and returning him 120 dollars gold of the money and a list with 75 colones to be collected here hence he thought best to go on to New Orleans in the meantime.




