En un periódico josefino, al comentar en días pasados un párrafo de nuestro Boletín que vió la luz pública el Domingo pasado, se dice que nosotros denunciábamos hechos de suma importancia sin dar nombres propios que dan á nuestras aseveraciones algún peso ante la opinión pública.

Se les sigue la tramitación judicial por tratarse de hechos que caen bajo la sanción del Código Penal; de esto bien puede cerciorarse el colega si también lo desea.

Es por ella precisamente por quien esperaríamos ser juzgados, y ella está con nosotros, porque la Opinión Pública es el Supremo Juez, y ese juez inexorable ha visto como nosotros, que la United Fruit Company ha usado de proceder en verdad poco correctos.

SEÑOR DIRECTOR DE EL LIBERAL.— E. L. C.

En relación á una entrevista que á principios del mes en curso celebré con un repórter del popular Diario de usted, trae ésta en su edición de ayer el siguiente despacho telegráfico:

RECTIFICACIÓN AL GENERAL SÁNCHEZ

Santamaría, 20 de mayo de 1912 LIBERAL--Bogotá.

Rectifico inexactitudes, contradicciones reportaja Eutimio Sánchez, publicado 4 mayo. Atiques United gratuitos. Unidad no intervinó asunto Ordenanza ferrocarril. Falsísimo, llevara gente barras Asamblea. Nueva trajo jamaicanos. Falsísimo pretenda adquirir tierras Apiguatí. Denunciante síguen todos colombianos. Inmensa mayoría empleados operarios Empresa es colombiana. Si Compañía explotara productores, Ciénega no prosperaría como asegura Sánchez. Armas usadas este señor, verdadas. Rechazo firmemente cargos todos inexactos. Verdad merece respeto.

Me parece, señor Director, que eso de amostazarse y hacer el oso, telegráficamente, á la manera del señor Montejo resulta un tanto molesto.

En el fondo de este asunto no hay sino algo muy sencillo y muy humano: el señor Montejo, nativo de Cuba, tiene que estar muy agradecido á la Frutera yanqui de Boston, que en vez de llamarlo Agente ó Representante de ella en el Departamento colombiano del Magdalena, á tenido á bien adjudicarle el pomposo título de Gerente in partibus, cuya jurisdicción no se extiende mas allá de los límites del mencionado Departamento. Por otra parte, el cubano señor Montejo no pudo convenir en que los colombianos protestemos y nos revolvamos unidos contra las expoliaciones de los yanquis, cuando cubanos como el señor Montejo se sienten tan regocijados con la férrea aplicación de la «recomienda Platt» y todas sus consecuencias: políticas, sociales y económicas.

¿Con que había expoliación ó no en los precios impuestos por la United? ¿Qué significa, sino expoliación eso de que apenas llega á Santamaría el

primer vapor de una Frutera rival, el precio del racimo sube en un 33 por ciento sobre el que pagaba la United? Esto paulatina y gradualmente fué elevando el precio por racimo de de 15 centavos (!) que en un principio pagó, hasta 30 centavos, que á la llegada del primer vapor de la Atlantica pagaba.

Voy á permitirle explicar á usted cómo clasifico en Santamaría los racimos los agentes de la United, para que usted, señor Director, en su alta equidad, se sirva decidir si tal clasificación constituye ó no una expoliación. Esos agentes consideran como de primera clase los racimos que tienen nueve manos, por lo menos. Ahí bien: cuando un racimo no tiene sino, veri gracia, ocho manos, pasa á ser considerado como de segunda clase; y para efectos de precio, dos racimos de segunda equivalen á uno de primera: es decir dieciséis matos equivalen á nueve.

Si expoliación no se llama esa figura, es porque ya para el cubano señor Montejo y para los colombianos descasados y sin decoro que, seguramente plácidos, pedirán para nosotros una embiensa Platt, las palabras han perdido la virtud de su pristina significación.

Situation in Guatemala

Mr. Editor:

Sir—I hereby beg that you will be good enough to place before your readers the following letter, with a view of warning Jamaicans and West Indians particularly of the happenings in Guatemala where these people are flocking in consequence of the announcements of the great developments being made by the new Railroad and Banana Farms in the country, so that they may understand not to go to that country as a coloured man's life is not worth the price of a sparrow there.

I would like to explain to your readers that I am now running away from my death which would have occurred in one of the company's hotels at Verginia. But before going further let me explain the trouble that is now standing in the public's eyes, especially the Jamaicans. First of all they are bitterly hated by the common Hoboes from whom the Jamaicans can stand no more, if a negro works for a contractor on the new road at Aztic and if his money is not right he dare not ask for it, he will either get a couple of kicks or two of the white men would jump on him and beat him half to death. This is the way Hoffman the contractor got his death at Quirigua on the 8th inst. The man that shot Hoffman his name is Brown a Jamaican, Hoffman fired nine shots at Brown with an automatic repeater and all missed Brown, who ran away to his camp and got his revolver and as he got near to the car that Hoffman and his timekeeper was sitting, the timekeeper saw Brown approaching and notified his Boss, but as the Boss could turn to look, he got a bullet in his mouth and fell to the ground, then he gave him two more. Now this I would say is self defence; the rest of the clints friends got angry over their friend's death and is taking revenge on any negro that the weapon falls upon. It fell on me but I was too quick and quit their job the same day and came away on the s.s. Cartago now on my way to Jamaica, therefore friends don't you go to Guatemala and think that there is a living to be made there just now, if you do, you will be sorry of your going. From the evening of the 8th until the 15th three Jamaicans have been killed already in revenge, and

What next?

The following copy is a circular that is being sent to each banana grower holding a contract with the U. F. Coy. for permission to guard their farms:

As a guarantee of the banana contract which the U. F. Coy. has celebrated with you, it is urgent that you exercise a most especial and complete vigilance on your farms, for the purpose of preventing robbery of your fruit.

This company has obtained the aid of the Authorities for this purpose and I solicit of you the necessary permission that the authorities may, when so required by this company to enter your farm with such persons as they may deem fit.

Ed. What an interest is being taken now by the U. F. Coy. in the growers, when will they start gathering the fruit themselves at their cost, will the Company not adopt us all as her sons, what next can anyone suggest to the Company?

In reply to your letter of 19th inst. I hereby give the necessary authority to protect my farm and to prohibit the entry on my farm of any person not authorized.

I do think there will be many more as the outlaws have no government to control them. Every white man carries the law in his hand, no soldier can arrest him, as the company feeds them and pay them 200 dollars which amounts to 12 cents in gold per day and their officer gets 25 dollars gold per month, this will let you know that the government has no jurisdiction over the white outlaws who nearly all stray from Texas Prairies out here. The fellow who shot at me his name is Ericson, a Dutchman, a country man of Hoffman. Although I was 18 miles away from where Hoffman got killed, he tried to take revenge on me. He took breakfast with me that morning before the train came but of course as all of Sue's kids look alike so we'll get them hence he thought he would go for me.

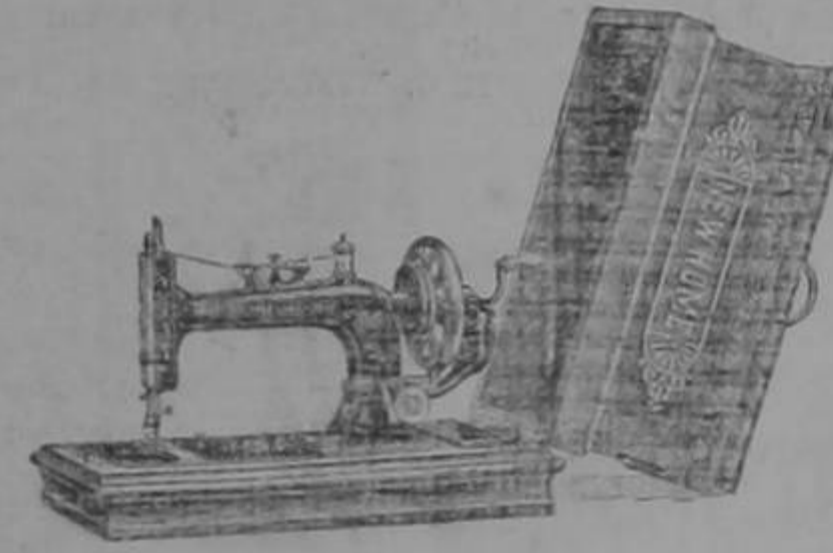

SOLDIERS ON THE SCENE

It was circulated around town yesterday that the U. F. Coy. had requisitioned the Government to send them 200 soldiers to protect their fruit, we learn later that 100 were sent 50 to the stations along the old lines and 50 along from Siquirres to Liron. Peculiar speculations have been current in consequence of the misunderstanding of the mission of these guardians of the peace it is well that the public should understand that the Government is perfectly impartial in these dealings. This Government is only watching to see that no industry which will tend towards the prosperity of the country is smothered. It is to the interest of the Government to see that both the U. F. Coy. as well as the Atlantic Fruit Coy. conduct their business in their own lines without attempt to illegally harass the industrial elements of the country hence these soldiers are sent to see that the fruit of the U. F. Co. are not stolen by the growers or the sellers to the Atlantic Co. as well as to guard that no undue pressure is brought by the U. F. Coy. or N. R. Coy. on the people who use the railroads or bye-paths as well as that the fruit of the Atlantic Coy. is not destroyed or taken away without their consent as was done last week.

Receiving bananas

We understand that as a consequence of the disturbances taking place on the Railway lines over the receiving of bananas, Mr. Wetmore has received the following information from the Minister de Fomento:

With reference to the fears that you indicated to me yesterday verbally of the refusal of the Railway to receive in other places than the stations, the bananas of the Atlantic Fruit Coy. which you represent, I take pleasure in stating to you that the bananas will be taken up at any point along the line where they may conveniently placed under similar conditions as those of the U. F. Coy. but it must be understood that the bunches ought to be placed at visible points 8 or 10 feet from the track and in a manner so as to render their traffic convenient.

Wire Entanglement

On Thursday morning the latest achievement of the Northern Railway Company's Officials, is to fence in the entire lands of the company fifty feet on both sides of the Railway lines leaving no gateway of any kind but on properties holding contracts. The provisions to which we made mention in another column as having been stored in the Bodegas of the Northern Railway went out by extra that

Public Pathways.

With reference to the fencing done by the Northern Railway Coy. with a view of blocking all the roads by which the fruit is brought for shipment, we understand that the Representative of the Atlantic Fruit Coy received a telegram from the Minister de Fomento yesterday afternoon that the Railway cannot prevent pedestrian traffic for industrial purposes along or across their tracks and where a pathway has been permitted for over a year, such a pathway cannot be obstructed but becomes a public highway.

Embargo on Fruit

Again this week extra cars and special trains by the scores are in evidence apart from dozens of extra trains going up and down taking out men, material and rations for the men working on the wire fences. There was another yesterday at eleven o'clock from San José bringing Mr. Stanley Lindo and a lawyer for the U. F. Coy. who it is said has come down to embargo the fruit bought by the Atlantic from certain farmers as well as farms. This lawyer along with the Judge and necessary officers left at 4:10 p.m. to embargo fruit along the lines. We await details.

Inspectors On Duty.

A man named William Wallen, a native of St. Kitts, died in a poverty stricken condition at Don Vicent Hernandez house and had to be buried by the Junita de Caridad. It is strange that none of his comrades from St. Kitts attended the funeral nor paid the slightest attention to him. None but Higiene Inspectors Pardo and Victor Ugaldes followed the corpse borne by four labourer at 6:40 p.m. on Thursday. He was a young man of 22 years old and is said to have died from beriberis.

morning to feed the men who are working on the fencing. Mr. Marks, carpenter for the U. F. Coy. and others have been running around town engaging men to go out to work on this fence.

We are no authority on having, but it seems so stupid to think that any corporation can wave power to enclose a road way which has been in existence for many years, possibly as old as the corporation itself, at consent would be futile.

However we will wait and see what the Government will say to this, as possibly the companies would like to take over the government, possibly this is a shadowing of the annexation scheme.

More Trouble.

It is said that the U. F. Coy. has asked the Government for 200 soldiers or police to watch over the properties of all banana growers having contracts with them. In consequence they have sent out printed circulars to all these proprietors to be signed giving them authority to watch over their farms from trespassers.

At midday yesterday a squad of police was detailed for duty at Trebol farm where there seem to be trouble, due to the delivery of bananas there by certain farmers for the Atlantic and the opposition by the U. F. Coy. It is said that these farmers have leased their lands from properties are free from obligations to the Coy. but apparently the company thinks they are included in the contract with them, hence the trouble. According to this, it would appear that the tenants are free to sell to whom they choose.

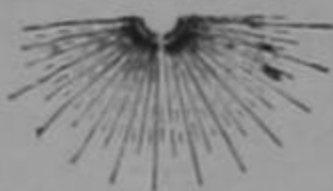

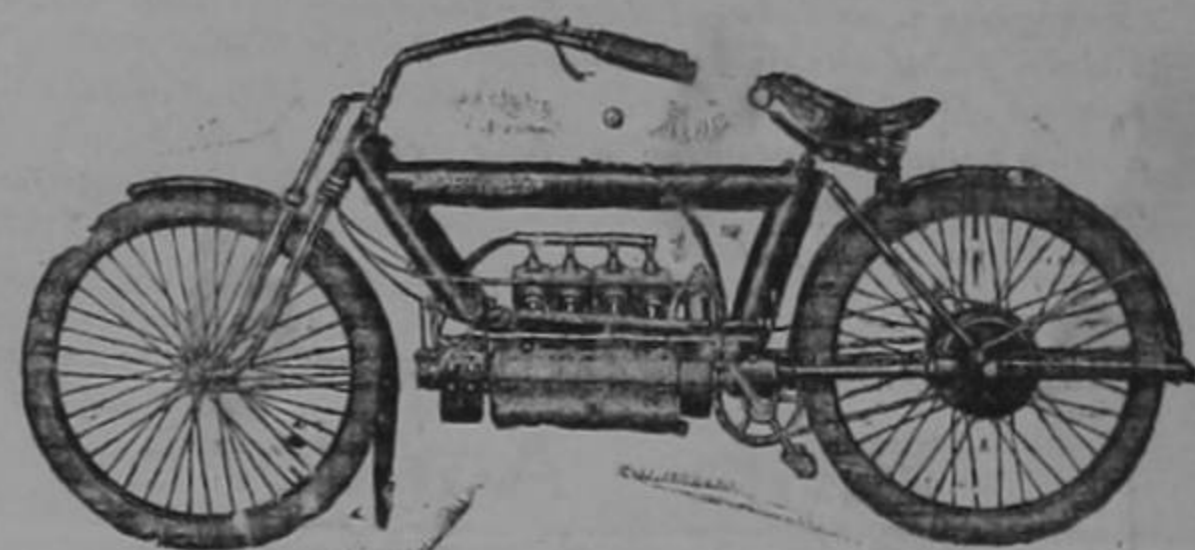
