Carta Abierta

Al señor Presidente de la República,
Licdo. don Ricardo Jiménez

Señor:

Desde el humilde rincón de mi casa, como Republicano que he sido y soy, y especialmente como Fernandista, a enyo partido estoy afiliado, tengo plazer en elevar á usted mis más calurosas felicitaciones, aunque tarde, por el acto de energía que usted ha desplegado en el presente conflicto suscitado entre las dos Compañías fronteras; y digo que como Fernandista, porque considero que todo el que lo es aplaude ese paso dado por usted y su Gobierno. A usted como hombre prominente, de talento, honrado de palabra sincera para los pueblos, las filas republicanas, en cabezadas por el Licdo. Fernández, en eructa lucha cívica, lo elegimos con entusiasmo para ocupar la Primera Magistratura, llenos de fe, confiados en que en ella, como lo ha hecho, con sus sabias decisiones, salvaria al País, a quien encontraba en tristísima bancarrota fiscal, abriéndole nuevos rumbos al Progreso, éxitos que si no se presentan...

Algunos días a que exijo mis justos conceptos, juzgándolos lejos de la adulación y tendientes tal vez á que se me conceda alguna prebenda; y habiendo manifestado al Gobierno en toda sinceridad, mi falta, causa que dio lugar á mi renuncia del puesto que ocupaba, tales suposiciones en la la ma-estan, no queriendo puesto, me basta con los sencillos que ha sufrido.

Si hay un círculo en el País, si hay una parte de la Prensa, que de algún tiempo a esta parte se han dedicado á la ingrata tarea de hacer creer al Pueblo que entre usted y don Máximo Fernández existen disgustos ó diferencias que los tienen distanciados en la política, aprovechando esa oportunidad para lanzar celos contra usted y herir al mismo tiempo la delicadeza de don Máximo, tendientes á que la ruptura sea un hecho, y sin consideración á la honorabilidad de ambos, habemos muchos de entre ellos que no damos crédito al maquiavelismo de esas intrigas.

Como Agente Principal de Policía que fuí en Guápiles, enterado de los disgustos que con alguna frecuencia se sucedían por reclamos de la Superintendencia de la United Fruit, pude per-^{ce}birme de que de un momento á otro,—sia que entonces figurara la Atlantic Fruit para nadie,—podían presentarse al Gobierno serias dificultades, con consecuencias fatales por lo que solicité de usted una audiencia, en la que tuve el honor de exponerle lo que ocurría en la linea, respecto de la faja de terreno del Gobierno y de lo que corría, confidé al Ferrocarril de Costa Rica; el aumento y organización de la Policía; la nacionalización de aquellos lugares y la necesidad de que el Gobierno tuviera conocimiento perfecto de todo lo que sucedía en cada una de las fijas de aquella región.

No quise manifestar á usted abiertamente mi opinión por temor de que me juzgara iluso ó obcecado; pero es lo cierto que tanto los fiequeros del País, como en algunas partes la United Fruit Company comprenden dentro de su terreno unos el todo y otros parte de la faja del Gobierno. Fué entonces mi opinión y lo es hoy, que en esa faja así como en la del ferrocarril, no han debido permitirse construcciones ni arriendos de ninguna naturaleza: en la primera, porque la Ley, en una extensión de veinte pies, la ha destinado exclusivamente para camino ó carretera; en la segunda, porque consideréndolo como lo ha cometido la Compañía, se han violado los tratados existentes acerca de la materia, toda vez que en ellos se estatuye que las únicas coras licitas en dicha faja son aquellas que faciliten con comodidad el servicio y marcha del ferrocarril y nada más.

El Gobierno actual sabe que la Compañía del Ferrocarril persibe regular cantidad de colones por derechos de piso en esa faja, debido á construcciones de casas de jamaicanos é hijos del País, cosa irregular, porque esto no está comprendido en ninguno de los contratos.

La tolerancia y liberalidad de nuestros mandatarios anteriores han dejado al Gobierno de usted, con el consentimiento de sus hechos, una cuestión jurídica de gravísima trascendencia, como la es la de la prescripción, manteniendo al Gobierno, á este respecto, en situación bien tirante y que forzadamente tendrá que resolver, salvando la dignidad del País.

We remember some time ago when two children got killed by one of these things at Jamaica Town. A better check of these articles ought to be kept by the conductors. That man might have been struck in his eyes instead of his back, what a difference this would have been.

School for

Detective.

The "Prensa Libre" has written an article on the propositions made by Don Luis Castro Saborio to the Government and the favourable opinion of this Government of those propositions which have as their object the opening of a school for training detectives.

This is a very advanced step and proves how quickly the Government of Don Ricardo Jimenez can grasp at any idea for the advancement of her people along the lines of progress and civilization in keeping with other countries. In a country like this where there is such a diversity of opinions, nationalities, creeds and colours due to the ever increasing arrivals day by day in consequence of which there must always be the customary influence of evil present in every rising town and as an effect of this, the corresponding amount of crime emanating from this influx.

It is high time that an efficient detective force be encouraged and tutored by experts in the profession, so as to cope with the present-day rascality, as we said some time ago education is for a great part used today for the deepest rascality, hence those to unearth such rascality must of necessity themselves be well educated.

We are proud of the move.

Fire in the Market

On Sunday a very serious accident might have occurred by which the entire market could have been destroyed by fire. A man named Smith from Zent came to town and as he said bought a vial of vitriol from a drug store (he did not say which); he went to a fresco stall at the North West of the Market known as Fred. die's to get a fresco, when somehow the bottle fell to the ground and broke, no sooner than the bottle dropped the whole place was in flames, fortunately it did not touch the woodwork of the stall or the market would have gone, the poor frightened man threw a bag on the flames to suffocate them, but no sooner than the bag touched the substance it disappeared in flames, water was thrown on it but had little effect until it burnt out on the concrete pavement.

In all this a police was not to be found; the man should have been arrested and an enquiry as to what drug store sold him this stuff as surely the law prohibits the sale of such dangerous explosives or flammable materials to unknown parties as they can very readily be adopted to criminal purposes especially in this province where fires are so prevalent from causes of revenge or gain. The man said he bought this stuff to kill ants, but this is always the plea, which ends in crime at times.

Heavy Death Rate

Limon is like France, her population is decreasing had it not been for continued immigration. There were born in Limon during the month of May 15 male children and 5 female, meanwhile there died 17 male and 10 female persons. There were two civil marriages and one Catholic.

In Puntarenas there were born 26 children as against 16 persons dead, in San Jose 149 births as against 112 who died, in Cartago there were 90 births to 41 deaths, in Alajuela 58 births to 45 deaths, in Heredia there were 42 births as against 36 deaths, in Liberia 5 births and 5 deaths. Hence Limon will be seen to be the greatest death trap of the Republic according to the statistics.

Accident to Coolie man

Last week some time a fatal accident occurred by which a die pedlar got his back broken. It appears that the carpenter gang repairing buildings for the Northern Railway was running on a pump car between Matina and Louisa West when they met this Coolie pedlar who begged them for a ride, they took him up and when in running he seem to have hung his feet so low that they caught on the ties pulling him under the car and in going he seem to grasp under the pumping bar of the car which he down in his chest and laid him half on top and below the car. He has been to the Hospital where he die at any moment as the ones think him a hopeless case. He gives out a story that when on the trolley beat and kicked him, but this is all false.



HIGH HANDED ACTIONS

Whatever can be explained in the columns of this journal, seem always to arouse a keen pleasure in the Directors of "La Información" and "La Republica" for rivalry by contradiction. The public is fully aware of the veracity of every statement made by us relative to the accomplishments of the officials of the U. F. Coy. of a week ago and themselves must acknowledge in their heart of hearts that every statement made was scrupulously truthful. This week will those journals contradict that roads that existed through different farms for years and years have been stopped by wire and trees fallen across them at the instance of officers of this Coy. Will they deny that embargoes have been made on fruit over which the company had no control whatever, in spite of being clearly explained to them? Will they deny that graft and corruption has been going the rounds by men sent out offering big prices to bribe witnesses to prove that they saw certain bananas being cut from contracted farms? Will they deny that the officials and men of the company were well provided with arms?

We are yet to learn when those arms passed through the Customs, as we have very few dealers in such thugs here. Will they deny that the officials of the company acted as officers of the police guards, giving orders as to what had to be done and in spite of the fact that Mr. Marshall proved to the police by documents that the Atlantic Fruit Coy. has legitimately bought and paid for those fruit, yet they refused to deliver them stating that Mr. Farrer said not to deliver them and worse yet that the police refused to sign to the above statement when asked to do so? These abuses go to prove that the U. F. Coy. is using might as right and as we have that confidence that the Jimenez Government cannot be bought we feel that it is time that the Executive Body ought to rigidly investigate this matter and put an end to these atrocities, as it is having the effect of crippling the banana industry as well as the commercial life of the Province.

There are several people who would have sold fruit last week but they were frightened by the Agents of the U. F. Coy. telling them that the Government were sending police for the U. F. Coy's exclusive use. It is time that the Agent of the Atlantic Fruit Co. appeal to the Government to decide the rights of this monopoly of the fruit of Costa Rica. Even in Colombia this assumed monopoly has not been upheld less should it be in free Costa Rica, a test case of the recent contracts would decide our fate, besides why does he not question the responsibility of Mr. W. E. Mullings as Administrator of the F. C. C. R. He may be Gen. Manager of the U. F.

Coy. and Northern Railway but we do not think that the Government looks upon him as the Manager of the F. C. C. R. as yet, this concern being practically government property conceded to the bondholders of that Co. under certain conditions. Whether those conditions are being upheld or set aside by the recent actions of Mr. Mullings are matters that Mr. Wetmore ought to decide.

Abuse of Power.

There comes a serious case from Puntarenas where a Jamaican Daniel Ritchie reports that he had permission from the Maestro at the Spanish School that his child should remain at home for a couple days in consequence of the illness of his wife, it turns out that on Thursday while his leave was still unexpired, a policeman and the boy that acts as policeman for the school went to his premises to collect one dollar and eighty cents fine for the absence of the child, upon which the mother remonstrated with them that her husband had permission to keep the child at home, however as soon as he comes home he would go down to the Director and arrange the matter as it was impossible for her to go, for he was ill having given birth only nine days ago. This did not satisfy either policeman nor the school runner, but rather insisted that the woman should go. Naturally the woman refused to go being ill, upon which both these savages fell upon the sick woman shoving, pulling and battering her just at a time in her life when she should be most quiet. The runner then pulled his revolver and threatened to shoot the woman if she did not go, whereupon a man who was watching the proceedings ran out and held his hand so that the gun dropped from his hand arrested that man as they were bent on bringing some one to town. It is said that the boy from the school was so drunk as to be staggering around the place. Mrs. Ritchie is now suffering from the effects of the battery. This is a case for Mr. Doswell the Vice Consul to act and prove himself, as this is away from the ties of the Company. We will watch developments.
