

La conspiración

El problema que hoy se resuelve, es de vida ó muerte para el País: si la Atlantic Fruit se va de Costa Rica, porque se le pone toda clase de obstáculos, queda como dueña absoluta del banano la United Fruit, y entonces, entonces podremos palpar las consecuencias de un monopolio que dejará al País en la más triste bancarrota, porque el agricultor nacional tendrá que vender sus productos por el precio que á la United le dé la gana; y sabemos que por desgracia, esta compañía echa mano de toda clase de armatoste para acaparar dinero, poseyéndolo todo, olvidándose de todo.

La audacia americana es peligrosa: ya en días pasados, Mr. Mullins con audaz serenidad, desmintió públicamente á las autoridades de Limón, y la Prensa de San José suprimió esta bofetada á la Nación con pasmosa indiferencia, y como Pilatos se lavó las manos, haciendo aparecer á este periódico como adulterador de la verdad.

El sábado 21, como á las 11 de la noche llegó el tren que recibió la fruta de la Atlantic Fruit Co. 

THE COUPON SYSTEM.

If ever there was a community that has exhibited the virtues of Patience it is Limón. "Patience a virtue" has been well borne out by the the labouring as well as the Commercial Community of this province and as Count Monte Cristo felt that all true human happiness is contained in the two words "Wait and Hope" so have we waited and hoped, and all things seem to come to those who wait in faith, so do we seem to feel today the realization of our hopes viz, the putting on equal footing all commercial enterprises. Coupon and Chips shall soon be a thing of the past and Orders shall represent cash wherever presented. From the inception of the Commissary system of the U. F. Co. the coupons has always been the leading feature of their success. Labourers Artisans or Clerks, have all had in their own way to submit to the Czarism of this system. A man gives his labour for whatever small wage may be allotted to him, he gets paid every 20 or 45 days as the case may be, his family takes ill and he needs cash to summon a doctor or other needs, he applies for an advance on his wages, he gets coupons, to convert this coupon into cash to meet his urgent needs, he has got to discount it with some dealer, losing twenty per cent of his already small earnings, because the dealer discounting his coupon cannot go into the Wholesale Commissary and make a purchase but must go into the Retail Dept. and buy at the same price that he must sell plus his incidental expenser. To the casual observer, the Broker may appear villainous but on investigation it will be seen that the 'fleecing' lies on the part of the Coy. How can we ever cease blessing and praising Don Anibal Santos and Señor Peralta for the stand they have taken in bringing before Congress this all important matter with the certainty of carrying it through because as he says "there is no deputy in this Congress that is sold to any Foreign Corporation" and as Deputy Santos says, "If there are any slaves in Costa Rica, they are labourers of the Atlantic Zone and Abaugares Mines or other industries where the labourer has to take his wages in coupons or chips." Hence let us hope that this slavery will die with the rising of Congress.

As justly observed in your last issue: we see on all parts of the lines, that contracts which for the past years had been so difficult to be had even when solicited, are now running daily to the door of the poor man who possesses a comparison of ten roots of bananas. We farther notice that the bananas which were greatly ignored by the U. F. Coy. viz. 6 hands has carried very high price on the 15th inst, as on that day it was seen that such bunch went up to the price of one colon paid by an official of the U. F. Co.

What has brought this about? My answer is Competition. Therefore to the far seeing man it be observed that a competition is needed. Let us encourage it by giving every available stem of fruit to the new company. Another remarkable point is this: We noticed for some passed years diseases of all kinds had taken hold of bananas and such would not be received, we see that a very clever doctor has effected a cure since the 9th inst for there is apparently no more diseased bananas.

Now if you should ask what is the cure for diseased bananas? My answer is the Atlantic Fruit and Steam Ship Coy.

Therefore let us all secure the services of that Dr. and not allow him to leave the country. Thanking you for space,


