Echos of Shooting Church Brigade. On "Alva" in Bluefields

A young man named Oswald Edwards, a Jamaican, came over from Bluefields and interviewed us relative to the recent occurrences at Bluefields on board the launch Alva belonging to Capt. Bruce Sergeant.

This man says that he was contracted here by Sergeant on behalf of the Atlantic Fruit Coy to go to Bluefields to work their plantations there. He left here on the Alva in company with 33 others, in the full conviction that he was going to work for a responsible coy.,

but when he reached Bluefields they found they were fooled by Sergeant, for they were carried to a place 180 miles from Bluefields and delivered to one Sam Cooper, formerly of Limon to work for the Caribbean Coast Planters Coy. instead of for the Atlantic. They all therefore refused to land where they were taken to as they were told they were going to a place 5 miles from Bluefields whereupon Captain Sergeant threw the provisions over board and told them they had to land or starve. They all remained on this boat for three days entreating him from ashore to take them back to Bluefields because he took away the battery and sails from the launch, the men then started to pull up the anchor whereupon Captain Sergeant started firing from ashore on them all with a Winchester rifle by which Edwards got shot in the arm breaking it. The men were then landed and he taken back to Bluefields,

Lindo Fruit Company

En una conversación que en días pasados tuvimos con Mr. Cecilio V. Lindo, tuvo la amabilidad de manifestarnos este señor, que la compañía que bajo la razón social se denomina Lindo Fruit Company, tiene la resolución de radicarse en Costa Rica, y que para el efecto, está él (Mr. Lindo) comprando terrenos para hacer nuevas fincas; que a fines del mes en curso partiría para Toronto en donde permanecería algunas semanas, y que luego regresaría para establecerse definitivamente en este suelo.

Le interrogamos á cerca del pleito que tiene pendiente con la Atlantic y nos respondió que en caso de perderlo él, con el dinero que le entregaría la Atlantic compraría nuevos terrenos para la Compañía Lindo Fruit de la cual es socio gerente y Administrador General en Costa Rica.

Nos agregó que en la actualidad tenía ya compradas más de dos mil novecientas cincuenta hectáreas de terreno para cultivarlas por cuenta de la Lindo Fruit.

Esto, á nuestro parecer, reviste grandísima importancia, y nos extraña mucho que los periódicos de San José, como *La República* y *La Información* que alardan continuamente sobre todo en las últimas ediciones, de patriotas que han extendido la mirada hacia el más allá, y que ven solo el bien que pueda reportarle al país, nos estafia decimos, que hayan guarda-

do un silencio tan curioso, sobre todo tratándose de Mr. Lindo, persona que le ha hecho tantos beneficios al país, y bajo cuya sombra se han hecho tantos capitales.

Este asunto de Mr. Lindo y de la nueva Compañía que va á venir, es de gran trascendencia, porque el solo hecho de que habrá mucha mayor competencia, será una alerta para los agricultores, que en vez de hacer arreglos con la Atlantic, esperarán á que llegue la otra á ver si les conviene más la proposición que esta última pueda hacerles, redundando este hecho insignificante en apariencia, en perjuicio de la Atlantic.

Lo que falta saber, es si no ocurrirá con la Lindo Fruit lo que ha ocurrido con la Atlantic que después de hacer los gastos para venir hasta aquí, Mr. Lindo, la abandonó, pasándose al opuesto bando, es decir: A la United Fruit Co.

No nos dejemos alucinar, los hombres que mucho ofrecen cumplen pocas veces lo ofrecido y como las mujeres, escriben sus promesas, allí donde pudieran borrarse con más facilidad.

De todas maneras, siguiendo la misma regla de conducta de los diarios de San José con la Atlantic, es bueno que los agricultores esperen los resultados, á la vuelta de Mr. Lindo y que antes de comprometerse recuerden que la ley, obliga á cumplir los compromisos que al amparo de ella puedan contraerse, aunque no sea más que una opción.

Viejo Mundo, que tras las visitas hechas, quedaron sorprendidos de la prosperidad cada vez mayor de aquellos países, especialmente de la Argentina, que está orgullosa de su grandeza, empezando ya los hombres de esta última República á preocuparse de otros asuntos más elevados que los sempiternos comentarios al comercio de las carnes congeladas y á la exportación del quebracho, tema exclusivo hace poco de las conversaciones de los argentinos.

Más que los de ninguna otra nación, los escritores y actores franceses han encontrado una hospitalidad cordialísima, no careciendo, ni mucho menos, de numeroso público los conferenciantes galos.

Causa extrañeza al observador la particularidad de que no se hayan dirigido antes todos los argentinos en demanda de intelectuales á la madre patria, España, que por cierto, no carece de literatos y artistas de una cultura verdaderamente superior, pero esto se explica dado el carácter de los españoles, cuyo espíritu hidalgo repugna las combinaciones comerciales, no sometiéndose á la costumbre establecida por otros de contratarse para ir allí á dar conferencias.





Which we have been able to place the fruit industry of that country on a substantial basis to the grower. Therefore do not listen to idle proposition that may be put to you for the object of getting us out of the way, and then bring you back to the former disastrous state of affairs.

Now is your time Planters! Open your eyes and help to encourage competition in the country. It is our intention to treat every man alike, and to help the small Farmers to cultivate his holding for our Mutual Benefit.

THE EMBARGO LAW.

The feelings in the Province are running very high against the high handed actions of the U. F. Coy. by the embargoes put against the property of people who have no business transactions whatever with them, and if the Government does not take quick steps to remedy the defeats of the embargo law it is feared the consequences will be serious.

This law, to say the least of it is particularly unjust, and in saying this we feel putting it very mildly and it is a wonder that some of the lawyers in Congress who have had intercourse with countries more advanced in civilization do not look to repeal such a ridiculous law, or put in an amendment. In no civilized country is such a thing permissible, the idea that anyone who cares to hamper another has perfect right to levy on one's goods and close up his business before he has proven his case in the Courts. To imagine that a man feels he has a grievance against you, he does not state his case for the opinion of the Court first but he levies on your goods and chattels by depositing 20 per cent on the value he may put on his case; to recover your articles to start your business anew, you have to deposit the amount embargoed plus fifty per cent, meanwhile he only deposits twenty per cent, that is, a man embargoes one's property for 5,000 dollars, he lodges 1,000 meanwhile to go along with your business embargoed you must deposit 7,500 dollars, is there equity in a law like this? In the meantime he need not present his claim against you until 30 days by which time a man's business is ruined.

The Atlantic Fruit Coy. say that had they known of the existence of such an inequitable state of affairs they would not have invested here at all. It is time therefore that the government ought to see that this law is repealed or amended, as there is no equality in it, but rather appear to have been instituted by the powerful to hamper and harass the weaker.

Tactics of Rv. Officials

As is well known, all the bananas bought by or put out on behalf of the Atlantic Fruit Coy. for shipment on Sunday were embargoed on Saturday by the U. F. Coy. and shipped by the Boston boat on Saturday night. On Sunday at 2 p.m. Mr. J. H. Burke sent a letter to the Representative of the Atlantic Fruit Coy., Mr. Wetmore, informing him that the Railway Company was ready to hand over to him a corresponding amount of bananas to those that were embargoed, which offer was promptly refused by Mr. Wetmore on the grounds that the fruit was full three quarter meantime the fruit offered was full fruit besides the delay that would be

Echoes from Santa Marta

There has been a persistent rumour to the effect that the Atlantic Fruit and Steamship Coy. has had to withdraw from Santa Marta, whereas we see in "La Voz" of Santa Marta up to the 28th June that s.s. Albingia left there with 20,080 stems of fruit and that the Atlantic Fruit Coy. has asked permission to erect a Wireless station, as well as the U. F. Coy., hence the rumour seems unfounded as the papers from that town do not mention about any uneasiness in the financial standing of that Coy. We note in the same paper that the U. F. Coy. shipped in the month of May 360,487 stems from that port.

The International Bible Students' Association Hall was crowded on Sunday night last to its utmost capacity, so that many eager listeners had to stay on the corridor where they listened to the lecture given by Mr. V. E. Samuels. The subject was "The Kingdom of God." He proved beyond doubt that the Kingdom of God is not yet set up, and that none of the present kingdom is the Kingdom of God, but on the contrary, the kingdom of this world as the Scriptures style them which kingdoms will soon have to give place to God's Kingdom for which we often pray—"Thy Kingdom come Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven."


