Forde of that body, with the idea of encouraging the young men of Limon generally, to interest themselves in literature as well as to save by their earnings for the purpose of entering when they have saved enough and care to do so, some college in the States in connection with the great Pan African Association of which the illustrious Dr. Boyd is we understand, the promoter.

Now, in unity there is strength, and if ever the coloured people are to rise to any degree of distinction as a whole this end must be achieved by standing together as a solid mass. If the spirit of antagonism to each other, if the spirit of selfishness or arrogance is at all cultivated, then we may rest assured that even though we may have hundreds of Organizations, our power for good is forever destroyed. We remember some time ago when the St. Mark's Literary Association was being founded, the Rev. Forde was asked to join the movement and nominated 2nd Vice President; he at first agreed, but later on declined having any intercourse with the Organization, and to our surprise we hear of the Baptist Pan African Literary Association without even that amount of courtesy due to be exchanged between two Organizations of apparently similar intentions consisting of men of a similarity of creed, colour and class. Of course we are not attempting to pick the actions of any one of the officers to pieces, but we do like to see that oneness of sentiment in our people, equally as much as we detest that strangeness to each other, which we seem so ready to cultivate.

May the day come when both Societies may join hands and say, "Let us be the Literary Association and Athletic Club of Limon of an undenominational aspect," so we may all work together for our mutual good and remember that if ever in our lives we need the motto "United we stand, divided we fall," it is now.

Manual labour No Disgrace

Very often we come in contact with individuals who seem to think that it would be below

their dignity to perform manual labour. They feel that to soil their hands with honest toil would be degrading to them, such persons must have a retinue of servants about their private household to wait upon them or else they are miserable. If one of the treads of the step needs replacing, they must send at once for a carpenter to put in a new one, if the books are to be removed from one shelf to the next it must be done by the servant or not at all and so it goes through every walk of life. If this aversion to physical labour were confined to those who can afford to have all their wants attended to by servants, it would be some what different, but such is not the case. We see those who can ill afford to spend the money hiring work done which they might a great deal better do for themselves. What is the meaning of it all? It would be below their dignity to do it.

In contrast to the persons we have mentioned we find others who are refined, cultivated and educated, who really enjoy doing physical work when occasion demands it. They never have learned the carpenter trade, but if a tile in the fence needs replacing, if a shelf is to be put up these persons unhesitatingly go at it and do it themselves. Such persons develop self reliance and the ability to do things. They are not dependent upon others to do everything for them and more than likely they are much better prepared financially to hire the work done than others who are so loath to do anything for themselves. There is nothing derogatory in honest toil of any kind. It does not detract from us the dignity of a true gentleman or woman. Education and culture often shine out from beneath the grime and dirt of honest toil, and it often happens that those who shun from manual labour for fear of losing their dignity have none of this to lose. The ability to wield a pen or pencil in some clerical capacity does not of necessity make a gentleman nor does the ability to handle a pick, a spade or a machete makes a man less of a gentle man for using them. It is more apt to work the other way and make of him more of a man, for he is the man who learns how to meet life's emergencies and overcome the difficulties which to the man who does not know how to work are unsurmountable.

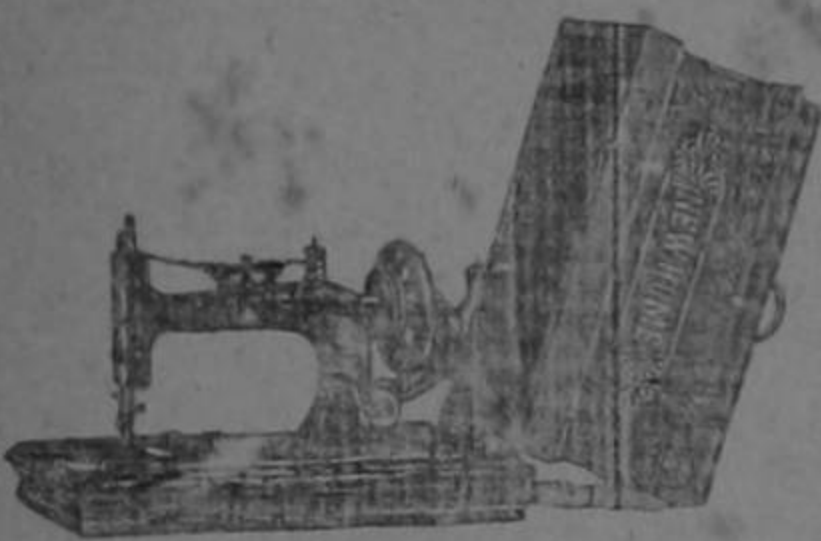

IS THE U. F. COY. A TRUST IN COSTA RICA?

From time to time we have seen occurrences during the present Banana struggle in Costa Rica, which lead us to imagine that the country is controlled by the influences of an Almighty Organization, but inasmuch as we have seen that this power has been used even to guide the destinies of the religious beliefs of the greater portion of the labour which is employed by this all-powerful organization, yet one could hardly come to the belief that the efforts we now see put forward to control and dominate the resources of the country were possible. We have seen as we say by one sweep the entire aspect of the religious regime of Limon set aside and changes in the Episcopal selections made to suit the orderings of this great omnipotent, we have seen dictators carried out to the effect that Limon shall never have the services of a coloured Priest, we have seen the passes of every coloured Priest or Clergyman withdrawn, and extended only to white Priests irrespective of denominations, thereby hampering the possible movements of the coloured Ministers of the word of God. We have seen every effort made for the prevention of the unification of the coloured people, we have seen by one great sweep the annihilation of the Union attempted among the labourers of this great octopus, as designated by a former writer, but never did we expect that one could have seen the intrigues and plots laid out for the monopoly of the fruit trade in Costa Rica as we today behold. 13 years ago we remember well the amalgamation of the Boston Fruit Coy. the Dumois Fruit Coy. of Cuba, and Santa Domingo as well as the Minor C. Keith Fruit interest of Costa Rica, styled as the United Fruit Coy. What has it developed into but a gigantic Trust, swallowing up every small exporter of this article. We find them swallowing the Tropical Trading and Transport Coy. of Costa Rica, The Camon Weinberger Coy. of Costa Rica, the efforts of Mr. Cecil Vernon Lindo with Sir Arthur Forwood of the Atlas Line also of this country. In Bocas del Toro, they have merged the Synder Bros. Macheca Bros., the Hynds fruit interest, the Clericy Fruit Coy. the Camors McConnell Fruit Coy., the John Wilson Fruit Interest. In Nicatagua, have they not put the Bluefields Steamship Fruit Coy. out of business? In Jamaica have they not put the Verley Fruit Coy. to silence? Did they not agree to undertake the selections of fruit for the Elder Dempster Fruit Coy., after Sir Alfred Jones gained the subsidy with the direct understanding that he was to select and buy his own fruit, did not the U. F. Coy. come in the deal and kill the competition which the Jamaicans all expected? And now what do we find them doing here, do we not find them using every means fair or foul to chase the Atlantic Fruit Coy.

out of the country, again endeavouring to close competition? Are these the actions of an independent trading Company, or are they the actions of a Trust? Is this a company to be sympathized with? Of course she has her claims and if rightly asserted they must be respected, but the methods employed are crude and if the Government does not rise to the occasion and investigate these matters, most assuredly they will soon lose forever all chances of shaking off the yoke of this all powerful Trust, which is capable of influencing even the elect with their cup of gold. Harsh measures deserve stringent remedies. We will however watch the work of the Commission and the decision of the Executive.

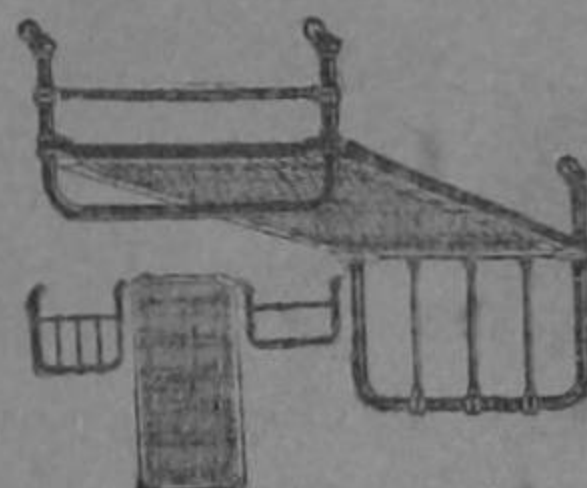

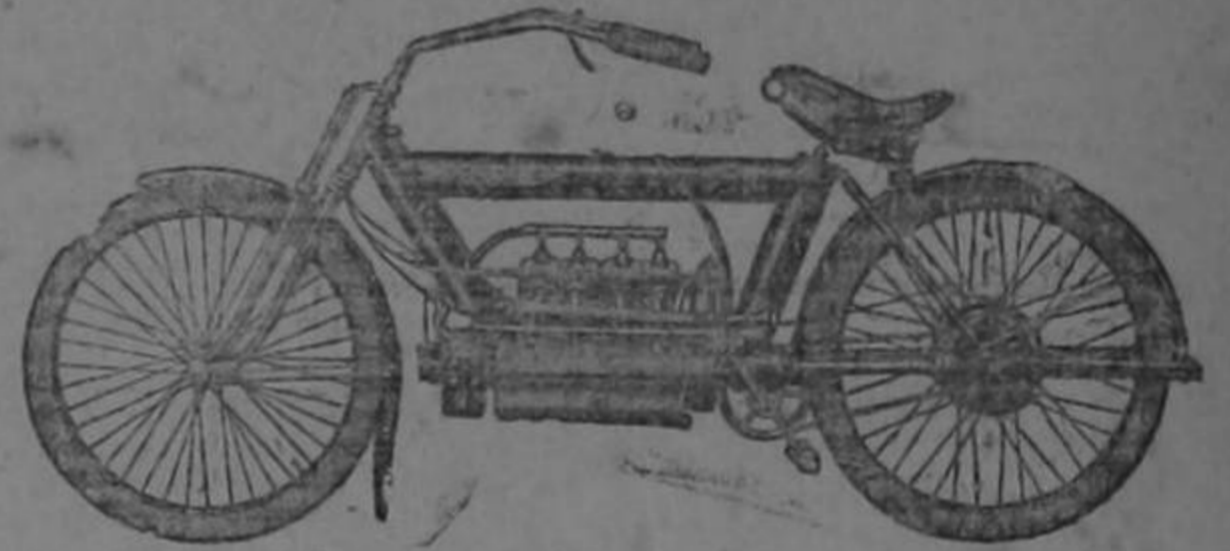

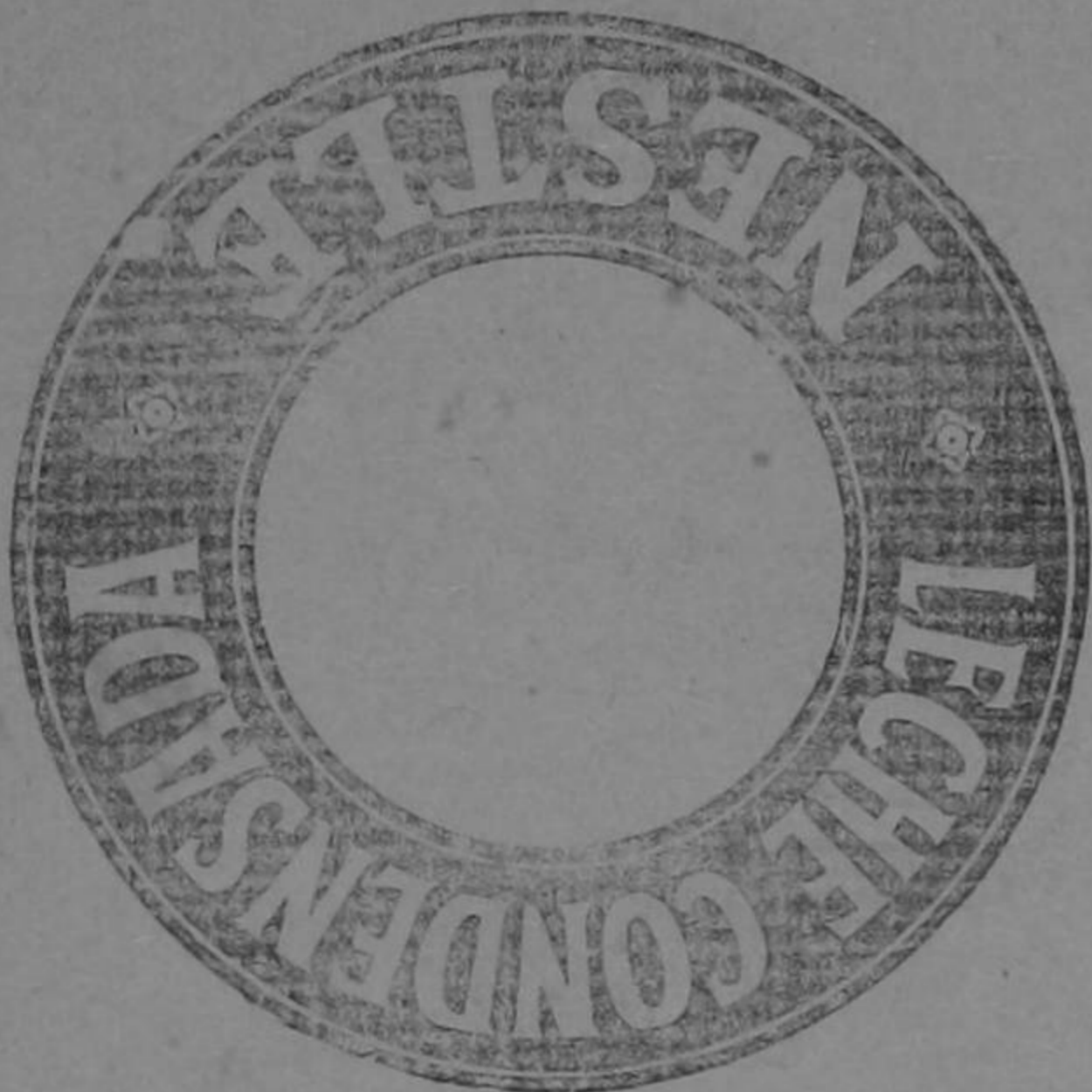
