A new Steamer

The Drina, the fifth of the new large twin-screw steamers intended for the intermediate South American passenger service of the Royal Mail Steam Packet Company, was launched by Hartland and Wolff (Limited), Belfast, recently. Her length is 517 feet 3 inches, and her breadth 62 feet 3 inches, the gross tonnage being about 11,500 tons.

The Drina is being constructed for Elder Dempster and Co. (Limited), but will be chartered by the Royal Mail Steam Packet Company. She is a facsimile of the Royal Mail Steam Packet Coy's new steamers Demerara, Desna, and Darrs. She will have holds insulated for the conveyance of chilled or frozen meat, and will also have compartments for dairy produce and fruit.

Banana Coy.

On June 5th, the Nicaraguan Banana Company, Limited, was registered with a capital of £50,000 in 49,000 seven per cent shares the "W. I. Committee Circular." Cumulative Preference Shares of £1 each and 20,000 Ordinary shares of 1s. each. To acquire concessions, estates and trading rights in the Republic of Nicaragua or elsewhere, to cultivate and deal in bananas known as "Banano," and plantains known as "Plantano," flour of banana or other kinds of flour, alcohol produced from bananas or from other products; ramie grass, fibres, palm kernels, oil, coffee, tobacco, coco-nuts, sugar and other produce, etc. and to carry into effect an agreement the parties to which are not named. The first directors are W. Coffinet and Baron di Kusel and the offices are at 26-30 Salisbury House, E. C.

A Burial Ceremony

We heard a very peculiar funeral ceremony was performed at Camp One during the past week.

Flour Stolen.

We learn that the Lamicq Mill has had a serious loss of over a hundred sacks of flour, and so completely have they changed hands and faces too, that no trace can be put to the perambulations of this flour, in consequence of which almost the entire staff, Motorman and all, have been let out to seek other jobs. Whether this mode of procedure will tempt anyone to let up as to the possible whereabouts of the flour, is a matter to be solved, for surely all could not be implicated.

Case of Colour.

We notice that the case of Mrs. Irene Harvey against the United Fruit Coy. for depriving her of a passage after she had booked same from Kingston to Colon, because she is a coloured woman, was set down to be tried on the 22nd. A special jury has been asked for. Mr. Phillip Stern, K.C. and Mr. J. A. G. Smith, instructed by Mr. T. R. McMillan, will appear for the plaintiff, while the Attorney General, Mr Hector Josephs, K. C., instructed by Messrs. Cargill and Cargill, will represent the defendant Coy. Great interest is being taken in the case.

Sanitary Methods

Complaints have reached us that the Sanitary Officers, in the execution of their duty in consequence of the plague scare, have been acting most arbitrarily. They have thrown the disinfectants indiscriminately in the rooms, infact it is said that they have broken into locked rooms, for this purpose. 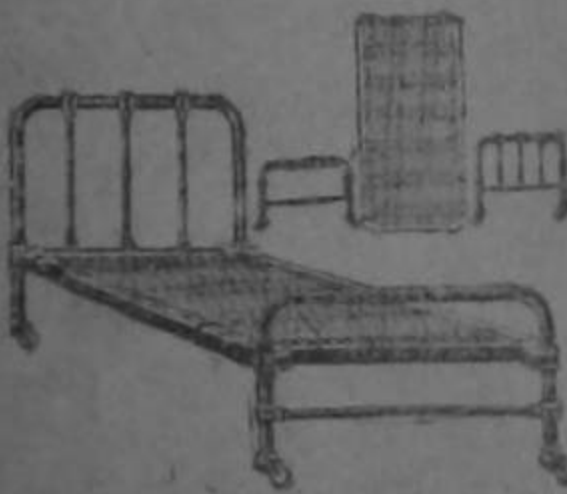

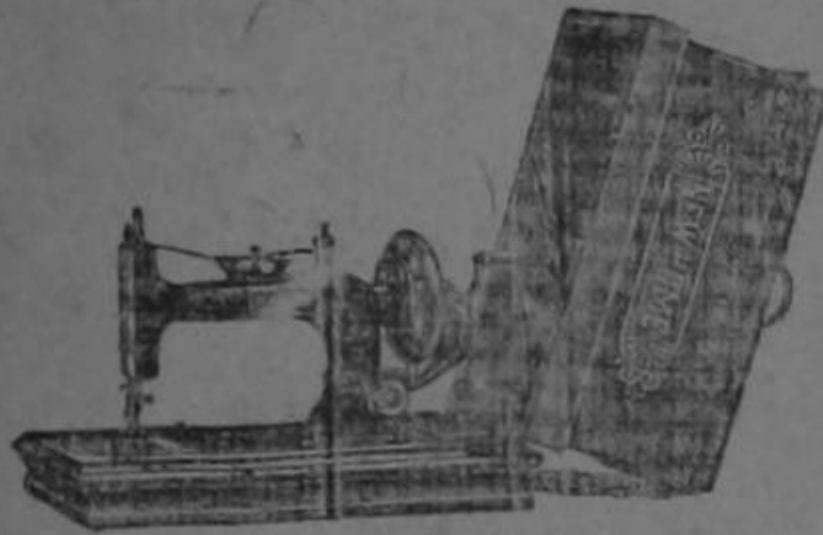

The embargo Law.

One looks all around him and at times feels disposed to ask, by whom is this country run? On every side we hear of "embargoes," and although we hear of the repealing of the law yet we see no efforts being put forward to cope with the present situation, and the recent developments seem to be brought about simply as a burlesque to the "embargo" Law and to show the government how far they can ridicule the absurdity of this measure.

It appears to us as though there is some great obstacle in the way of the amendment of this law and would like to sift and see what lever there is behind this law why it cannot be removed. When the Law on cock-fighting was to be annulled it took no time whatever to be considered and repealed; when the Election Law was to be amended it passed without any delay, why then is there such procrastination in amending a law which is so burdensome to the life of the country, the poorer man is the one who suffers most by this unjust law, which is tolerated in no other country we will venture to say. Why, even in Panama one has to prove his claim in the courts before he can close up his man, but here it is opposite. The merchant may well say he must be protected, against his debtors but his case is different, because his books being certified by the seal of a Notary Public, the accuracy of his accounts would be sufficient for the judge to institute an "embargo," but no claim apart from such or those accompanied by Pagaré or sound documentary evidence should be admitted under "embargo" until the judge has been satisfied with the validity of the suit; and even at that the merchant is protected by the publication of the sale of any establishment. We therefore hope that the Deputies will put such an amendment as to disallow this reckless monopoly of trade when so required by the Powers that be.

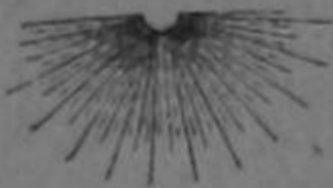

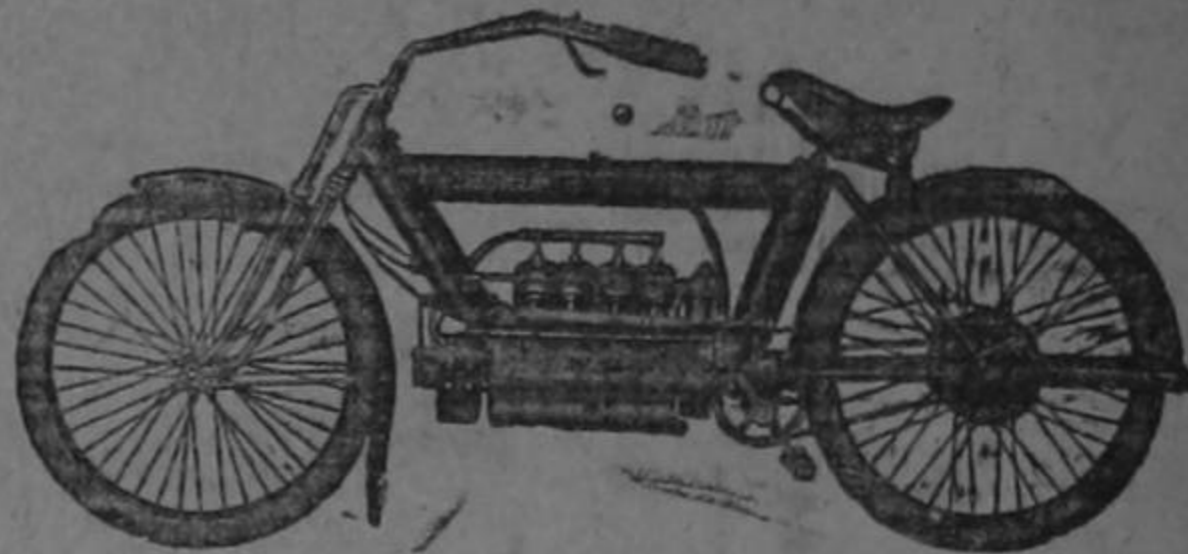
