Slides in the Canal Officers of the San José Union

News received from Panama says that the great Cucaracha cut has started to slide slowly, the movement started since the beginning of December, and is now very marked in its progress. A very great section of the eastern lower bed, the body of the slide broke away carrying with it 125,000 cubic yards of earth which has to be removed. The bulk of the slide affected is about one million cubic yards. This slide embraces an area of 47 acres. Last year very little excavation was done there in consequence of this slide and it was believed that it had slid to its natural slope. Consequently this slide has disturbed the Engineers very much however as this is the dry season of the year they calculate they will be able to remove it easily to suit the canal records. Up to the 1st January 1912 the amount of excavations done is 188,200,312 cubic yards leaving 24,223,826 cubic yards more to be done to complete by the same time, 1915. It is said that a movement in the rise of the Gatun dam is observed, but the employees of the canal ridicule the idea.

The officers of Federal Society of the labourers of San José, held their elections on the 12th inst., when the officers for the term were elected. They take offices on Wednesday night. The College of Druggists also held their General meeting the same day when Mr. F. Jimenez Nunez was elected President, and Mr. Carlos Salazar Oreamuno, was elected Secretary.

Pugilistic Arena

On Tuesday evening quite a sensational drama enacted in the yard of the Northern Railway which caused quite a large gathering and a suspension of work for nearly an hour. It would appear that a man named Golban and another Campbell, carpenters, had a quarrel over some frivolous matters, when a bloody fight ensued, Campbell vindictively using a large hammer on Golban's head causing a severe wound. Where were the police?

Conductor arrested

A few days ago after the passenger train had left Ler station from San José to Alajuela it came in contact with a yoke of oxen near Heredia: to prevent a serious accident, the engine was brought to a stand still in a few seconds, but the unfortunate man in trying to save his oxen was crushed and died a few hours afterwards in the Hospital. The conductor was arrested, and lodged in jail and was unable to return with the evening train.

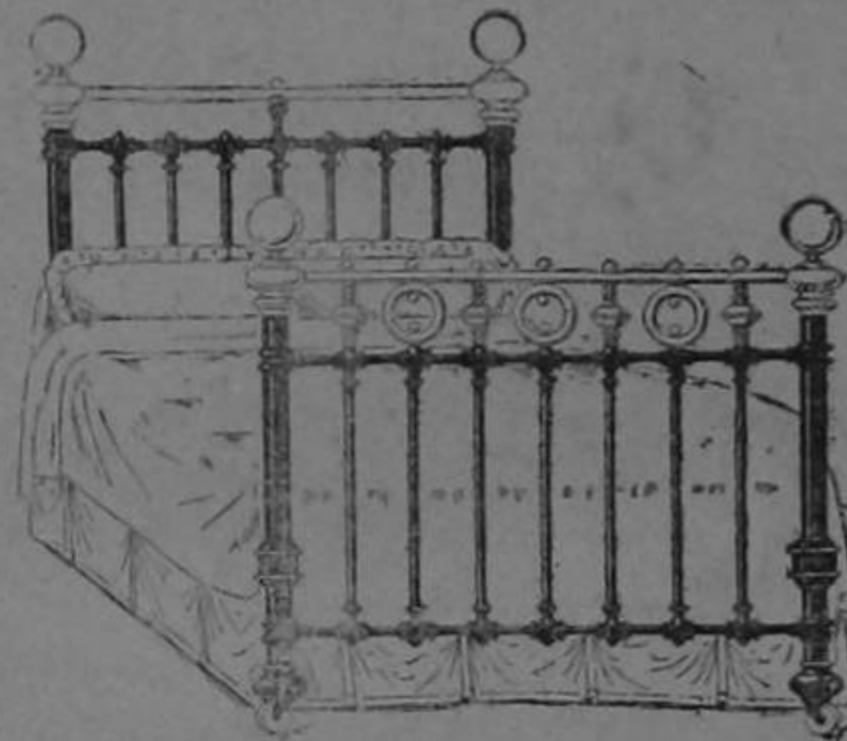
