Failure of Lodges GOOD NEWS

There have sprung up in and around Limon, so many Lodges that apparently the people seem unable to meet the obligations placed on them, and as for the most part there seem no real unity among them, but rather jealousy, the fact comes that they are called upon to face greater expenses than they would have had to face, were there a better understanding between them. Some time ago two Lodges implements were levied on for rent, and now four others have suffered in a similar degree.

The Mosaic Templars which embrace three lodges namely: The Rose of Sharon Chamber, The Joshua Temple, and The Excelsior Temple, organized by Mr. John Ivey as representative of the Mosaic Templars of North America. The Pearl of Bethlehem Lodge of the Order of the Star of Bethlehem of which Mr. A. A. Archer is representative, occupied a house belonging to Mr. J. C. Wilson, but being unable to pay the rents now for several months, the owner found himself obliged to embargo on their goods and chattels and close the door. Since the embargo has been made it turns out that the Bethlehemites owe no rent, but finding that the other three failed from coming up to their obligations, went to Mr. Wilson and paid theirs, hence their goods may be released; but in the meantime they are bound to suffer the inconveniences consequent on the embargo.

An interesting incident is that Mr. Francis of Camp One, along with Mr. DePass of the Syndicate, also suffer in the transaction; both being interested in an organ which one sold to the other on the installment plan, while the second party loaned same to the Rose of Sharon Chamber. A beautiful tambourine was presented before the Lodge room on Friday evening last, when there was the Majarajah, mounted in the centre of Mr. John Ivey, Mr. Archer, Mr. DePass and Mr. Perkins, who all stood looking at the sealed door in a hopeless thought of getting the organ in question.

Triple Suicide.

Vienna, Jan. 2.—A suicide pact which three youths carried out in a cafe here on Monday night has been explained by a young girl who says that the youths were all ardently in love with her and had threatened to commit suicide on her account. Three men were drinking in a secluded corner of the cafe when suddenly they fell from their chairs and died. They had evidently placed poison in their beverages and the result proved fatal in each case. A photograph of the trio was found in their possession addressed to the girl, who told their threats — "Gleaner"

A Great Slide.

CANAL MACHINERY BURIED BY LANDSLIP

Panama, Jan. 10.—After having remained firm for many months, the earth in the vicinity of the famous slide at Cucaracha in 1905 is moving again, and late yesterday afternoon more than 125,000 cubic yards of rock and earth fell into the cut. No lives were lost, but much machinery was caught beneath the mass.

Hundreds of men from the neighbourhood were hurried to the scene and will be put to work removing the thousands of feet of material.

From the appearance of the landslide, more than 1,000,000 cubic yards more of earth is in condition to come sweeping down into the cut.

The movement of the earth at Cucaracha was first noticed in the early part of December and is now becoming strongly marked over a large extent of eastern bank. The point at which the 125,000 cubic yards broke loose is on the eastern slope at the lower point of the entire loosened mass.

The Cucaracha slide, which began in 1905, has worried the canal engineers, but as this is the dry season they expect to handle the present situation without difficulty. More than three million cubic yards have been excavated at this point, but little material was removed from the district last year owing to the uncertainty of the slopes.

The area involved is about forty-seven acres, and owing to the long repose of the earth it was hoped its stability had become permanent.

Rumours that a movement of earth has been detected at the Gatun Dam are current, but these are ridiculed by canal officials.

Echo of the Barmouth strike

DAWNING OF POLITICAL ERA.

In another column will be found a notification calling together the friends of the Civil Party of the Politics of Costa Rica, to welcome the head of the party Don Rafael Yglesias who has been abroad on private business.

Within a few short weeks the electioneering campaign will have started, when all the forces of the different political parties will be brought to bear with the aim of putting forward before the public the man whom they believe to be the best Candidate in the interests of the country.

At the last election the counting was arranged in two sections. The Republican and the Civil Party, this time it is learnt that the Republican Party has been divided into another section namely the Nacional. Until now the Republican nor the Nacional Party have not yet identified themselves, but the Civil Party is the first on the field. There is no question that Don Rafael has done much to improve the civilized standing of the country, almost every thing portraying modern ideas throughout the country, got its initiative during the reign of Don Rafael. It is true there are several individual complaints against him one way or another, but as a public man it is hard to find his equal as an organizer, in this country, up to now at any rate his modern ideas, his improvements to the country has not been bettered.

We refrain from interfering in the opinions of those concerned, but we do hope that the best man will be chosen to pull the country from the financial slough into which she has fallen, and to get such a man needs all the thought, brain, financial tact and diplomacy that can be mustered in the country.

Improvements Of Siquirres.

Siquirres is on the move, under the guidance of our great Diplomat Don Antonio. The income on the Canton has increased considerably the estimated revenue for the year is 35,752 colones, meanwhile the expenditure is set down at 25,500 colones, the principal items being projected street constructions 6000 colones and police 4020 colones, incidentals are set down at 2,400 colones.

The streets in the Kirtley lands are supposed to be started in February, meantime the water supply will be completed by the end of the present month.

Inasmuch as the man who is supposed to have discovered the coal mine, is gone away, yet hopes are not frustrated in getting to the spot, a commission has been sent out to prospect for the mines and from reports sent back they seem to think they are well on the vein.

The payday has passed off and inasmuch as the people have all been paid off, yet there seem to be no business along the sections, everyone seem complaining that the buying capacities of the people are paralyzed.

Gambling and prostitution is ever rampant, it is a great pity a check could not be put on these crimes here,

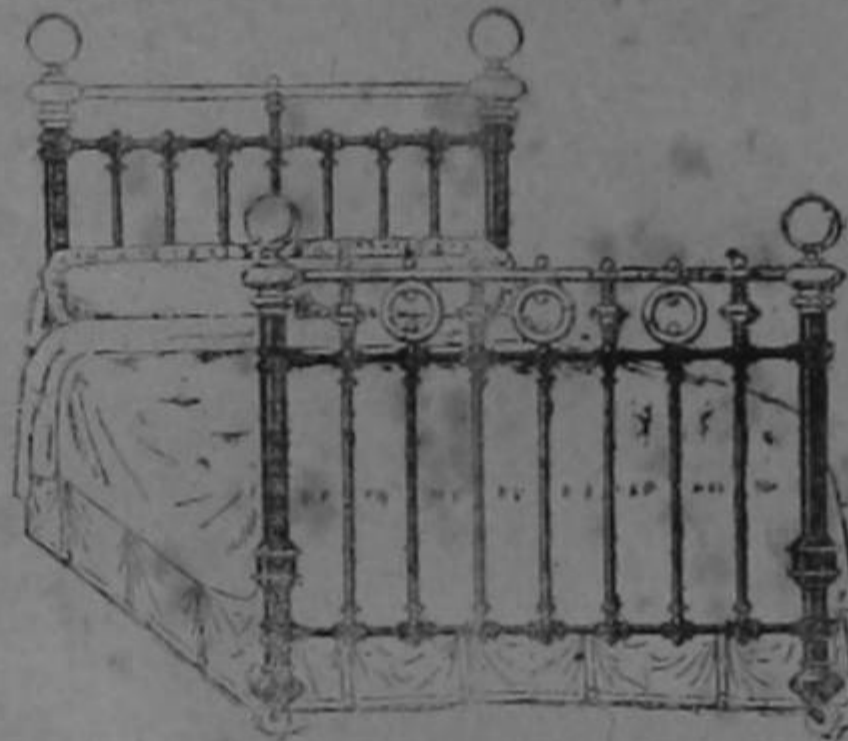
