

Echos of the Fire In San Jose.

Investigations as to the cause of the great fire in San Jose are proceeding, meantime the proprietor of the store Loures y Paris, Mr. R. N. Delcore, his two nephews, Nicolas and Domingo Delcore and a clerk, Antonio di Palmas are yet in jail.

It is discovered that the establishment was insured for \$10,000; this is, in a German House for \$1,500, in the Commercial Union for \$1,000, in the Palatine for 3,000 pounds, in the Nacional for 1,000 pounds, and in the Yorkshire for 2,000 pounds, in Ward Smith & Co. for \$1,500; all of these to expire between March and November of this year.

Up to this, nothing is proven against the suspected parties, to the contrary, it is thought that there would be no business on the part of Delcore, for whereas his liabilities are over \$100,000 his creditors would only be getting 90,000 colones, and i.e., nothing.

The Banco Anglo Costaricense, has lost nothing whatever by the fire, as their chest was found intact.

The House of Juan Knorr which existed in the destroyed premises for 73 years, has started business in his dwelling immediately.

Delcore thinks that the fire started in a back room of Echandi & Koberg, adjoining his tailoring shop where inflammable electrical materials and oils were stored.

Falsification in Singer Receipts.

More than 25 persons, are said to have been robbed in San Jose, by a Collector of the Singer Sewing Machine Coy by falsification of the receipts. The matter has been handed over to the authorities by the Superintendent in San Jose, Mr. Pagan, and the responsible party is now before the Courts to answer for his crime. This same thing was done here by one Watter, some months ago, whereby several persons suffered, it is only a pity his trick was not detected until after he left the country. Purchasers have therefore to be very careful to see that they get their proper receipts, when paying monies.

Kaiser's Birthday.

The Band was occupied on Monday afternoon, discoursing special pieces in front of the dwelling of Don Luis Kruse, German Consul, in honour of the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Kaiser.

A dinner was given by the Consul at his residence which was attended by the German Colony, as well as the officers of the Hamburg American boat in Port.

Echoes of The 50,000 from Nicaragua.

At 5 minutes to 2 o'clock on Saturday last, Don Zenon Castro lodged in Court a document containing the proofs against Don Maximo Fernandez, who is the Chief of the Republican Party here, and likely Candidate for Presidency at the next election, who prosecuted Don Zenon Castro for libel in the press, for assertions relative to the receipt by him of fifty thousand dollars from the Zelaya Government for assisting in the election campaign of the Jimenez party.

In his defence, Mr. Zenon Castro has put in several copies of newspapers containing the accounts of the attack on the Artillery Garrison on the 25th February, 1889, leading up to this litigation. He also calls for a letter sent by General Zelaya to Don Ricardo Jimenez explaining the causes for the forwarding of a sum of money to assist as he asserts in the Jimenez propaganda, as well as cables exchanged between Don Maximo and General Zelaya, when the Press of San Jose took up the matter of the \$50,000 and other documents. He also asks for a day to be named for taking the oral testimony in public of Don Ricardo Jimenez, who will answer questions contained in two sheets of paper, and of Don Francisco Aguilar Barquero, and Don Alberto Vargas Calvo, to say what was their conference of the Directive Board of the Party about, at the time when Don Maximo made the memorable trip to Nicaragua. And of Doctor Luis P. Jimenez and Mr. Jose Joaquin Jimenez, to explain what was their interviews with General Zelaya as well as what they know of the matter at issue; and of Don Miguel Obregon, Don Marcos Morales, and Don Santos Pastor, to testify of his honour and conduct in this respect.

Don Maximo on the other hand has called on Don Manuel Castro Quesada, Minister of Foreign Affairs, Doctor Manuel Dieguez, Dr. Rodolfo Espinoza, Don Federico A. Tinoco, Don Alvaro Hazera, to state whether he had ever told them as is asserted, that he had received this 50,000 dollars from Genl. Zelaya, or worse yet that it was intended for assisting in the Jimenez campaign.

This matter is causing very great concern in San Jose, as it may decide great things in the elections for presidency which will soon commence, hence we have translated same from "La Informacion."

THE CRISIS OF LIMON.

As is well known, the Province of Limon, and in fact the entire country is passing through a crisis that if nothing occurs to ease up its tension, the country must inevitably go in bankruptcy; not only individually as is being forced by certain residents of this town, but collapse in a body. And in all this trouble nothing seems to be as much the cause of it—as the controlling power of the great financial trusts.

We look around us we see finance monopolizing the rights for making the bread we eat, taking away the means of sustenance of the families of our poor bakers, by erecting factories and making combines by which the poor man is driven to starve or to serfdom. We go further, we see capital forming a controlling combine in the sugar interest of the country whereby the production of the sugar we consume is in the hands of three or four capitalists alone. Even the beef we eat finds itself in the hands of but a few men who wage war in prices when any one else attempts to enter the trade by which competition may arise.

Why, the government itself holds a monopoly in tobacco, and liquors which has become so stringent in its effect lately that a Commission has been requisitioned to enquire into the state of oppression brought to bear on those trading in spirituous liquors; for whereas formerly anyone could open a Canteen by paying a few colones monthly, today it is only the rich are allowed to live, who can pay from 400 to 700 colones quarterly for a liquor license, this curtailing the possibility of the small man helping himself in any other way but by physical labour to the advantage of capital. Last but by no means last comes the greatest of Trusts here—the Banana Trust. It would be useless to expand on the facilities afforded this trust, or the disadvantages suffered by the poor man at the hands of this gormandizer, for fear of being closed down immediately, as we have been threatened by its Detective and Attorney; but suffice it to say that she has chased competition from the country, and held up all the small settlers who were disposed to assist in bringing in such competition and better times for the struggling people. She has tried to cripple commerce by her coupon system, and now that that means is taken away she has scores of detective watching those who sell spirits and other goods on the farms. She has started putting innocent men in jail for offences which should be hunted among the higher element, for surely the motor car which took away the iron chest from Babylonia Commissary, had no right there yet no question is asked as to how this car came there, nor whose car it was and who took it there, nor how the bridge hammer came there, and from what gang was such a maul missing; none of these investigations are made by the detective in charge, simply because it seems as if all forces are directed against the poor, the weak and the feeble and when they are vanquished, the Capitalists feels he has done wonderful smart, and valiant things, by bringing distress and poverty to the door of the unfortunate, by the very means which God seem to have placed to his trust only as guardian and caretaker, and which he must soon leave to be administered by whom, he knows not.

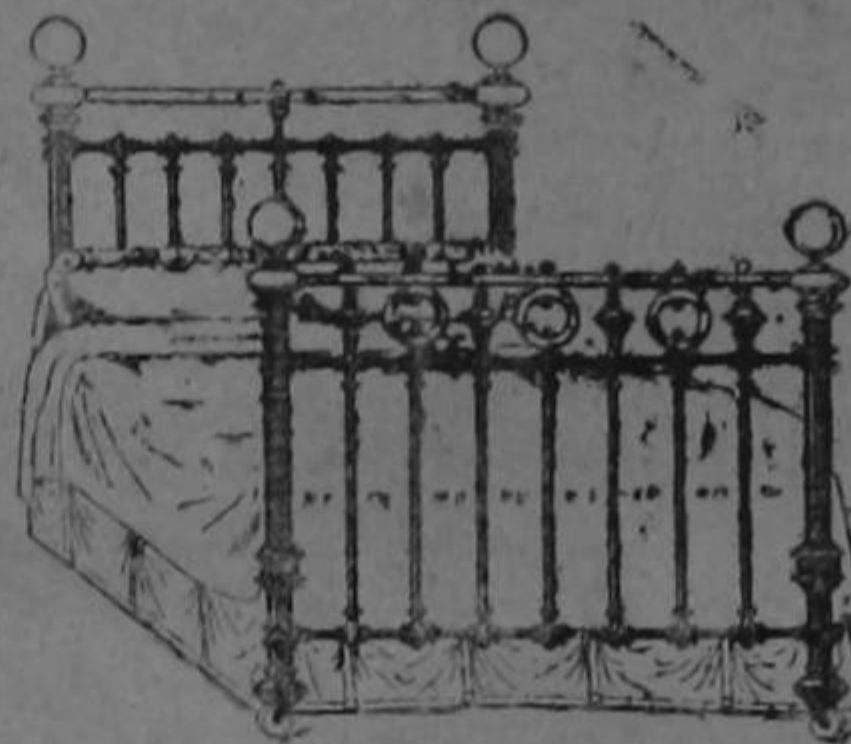
