After white Slavers

Rome, Feb. 24.—The Government has announced that it intends to adopt an amendment to the penal code which will make more severe the penalties for the white slave traffic.

The Government also intends to establish a police censorship over the moving pictures. The display of any immoral, anti-national or criminal or cruel subjects will be prohibited.

Treaty Ratified.

Washington, Feb. 28.—The Senate has ratified the American-Italian Treaty, by which the citizens of either country residing in the other, are accorded the same legal protection as the nationals.

A Battleship.

Berlin, March 4.—The Kaiser who was present at the launching of a Dreadnought at Wilhelmshaven on Saturday made an address in which he said that the launching of such battleships was the "Empire's greatest need in the present serious hour."

A machine Gun

London, Feb. 18.—A chemist of Hull has invented a machine gun whose projectiles, by means of explosion of gases, set on fire anything that they hit. The range of the gun is five miles.

Great Penalty.

LAW RECENTLY PASSED.

London, March 4.—Under authority conferred by the Aerial Navigation Act, the Home Secretary has issued orders prohibiting foreign military or naval aircraft from passing over any portion of the United Kingdom or territorial waters, except on invitation and by permission of the Government.

All other foreign aircraft coming to the United Kingdom are required, first, to obtain clearance papers from the British Consuls. Landing will be restricted to certain areas of the coast, where the pilots must report to the authorities and obtain a permit for the continuance of the voyage. They are prohibited passing over certain districts, in which are included the military and naval sections.

Anyone infringing these regulations, it is announced, is liable to be fined, and the offence is punishable by six months' imprisonment, or a fine of £200. Aeronauts guilty of espionage are liable to seven years' penal servitude.

Bermuda Bananas

"Shipping Illustrated" of New York, publishes the following:

"The export of bananas to England from Bermuda is expected to commence during the season. Hitherto there has been little or no shipment to that country, but growing has now been developed on a large scale. The fruit is grown from the seed of the Canary Island variety.

Chargé of Libel.

London, Feb. 26.—Lord Alfred Bruce Douglas was committed for trial yesterday on a charge of maliciously libelling his father in law, Colonel Frederick Hambleton Custance.

The defendant is alleged to have written telegrams and postcards stating that the Colonel induced his daughter to sign a settlement by undertaking to get her an annuity of \$3,000 a year, and that the Colonel is a despicable scoundrel and thoroughly dishonest.

New York, March 6.—A triple alliance of Venezuela, Colombia and Nicaragua is said by South American Consular Agents here to have been informally entered into by these Governments to prevent any return of General Castro to Venezuela. Three naval vessels are patrolling the Colombian Coast with instructions to thwart any landing of a Castro force.

General Castro, who arrived in New York last night, laughed at these reports, reiterating his denial of any intention to engage in any revolution in Venezuela or Nicaragua. He said he would depart shortly to rejoin his family in Europe.

An Explanation. Samaritans Day.

In our article on Insurance of last week, we alluded to the yeoman service that Mr. Smith was rendering to his Company among the labouring classes, to which serious exception was taken by some of the merchants and professional men, whose eyes Mr. Smith has succeeded to insure.

It was never our intention to depreciate the category of the gentlemen alluded to, but rather as a stimulant to our working people, as we knew that certain of them had spoken to the Agent on this matter, and we prided ourselves to know that the labouring classes were rising in Education to such an extent as to feel it a duty to provide for those whom they may leave unprotected behind them. Of course we might have been a little more careful in the use of the word, but knowing the term "working classes" would encircle so very extensive an area of the population of the Province of Port Limon, we hardly conjectured any offence by it.

Labourers Train

Again we have to refer to the treatment of labourers at Bananito. A week ago we spoke of the refusal of the Company's Officials to allow them to ride on the work train to come to town, now we have to speak of the fact of a special train going down to take in the farmers on Saturday last, so as to wring from the pockets of these unfortunate men, a few cents.

It seems so strange that some time ago we heard Mr. Crowley tried to get in the regular passenger train three times weekly into Bananito, so as to encourage men to get there, but it was refused him on the ground that it would not pay; but suddenly we see that a special is run from Limon into Bananito with 3 coaches for passengers without even letting the public know that such a train was to arrive; thus getting about 13 passengers.

The whole thing looks so ridiculous that one knows not what to think; now what did the Company mean in asking the authorities for police aid, did they mean to incite the people into insubordination? There has never been any necessity to carry four police on any passenger train, why should they have been sent on this train.

All these acts only tend to drive away the labourers from the Coy's farms, rather than getting on better relationship with them.

The officials are to blame for not being diplomatic with these under them. Formerly it was considered a pleasure to work under Mr. Keith, and his officers, but today all the good men who were accustomed to work in harmony with their Chiefs, are all gone or going away leaving only the green men who have just come in—much to the annoyance of the foremen who have so great a task to be always breaking in new men to the draft.

It is not a Saturday's special that the men seem to want, it is permission so long as they are on the Coy's business to ride on the work train. There is no need to drain their pockets of the few cents they earn, for the Hospital does enough of that—try to help them to make their families comfortable then Mr. Mullins will have loyal men.

Sunday, 9th inst., marked the 66th Anniversary of the organization of the Good Samaritan's Order; and it was celebrated in fine style at the Concordia Hall by the Reorganized Mt. Purity Lodge of that Order.

The Rev. Hm. Forde of the Baptist Mission was asked to take the ceremony and he gave a most enlightening lecture on the utility and Godfearing tenets of the Order, strictly exhorting the members to live up to the life that the Order directs.

The address was over and several representatives from various Lodges, gave short addresses and conveyed messages of love and congratulations from their several Lodges, during which time Mr. Earle occupied himself on the organ, much to the comfort of the guests, while ice cream and cakes were being served—a most enjoyable evening was spent.

The representatives were all asked to return on Monday evening when a similar programme was gone through. Bro. G. T. Sanderson occupied the chair on this occasion, when again the different representatives of the Lodges gave very stirring addresses on the good that Fraternal Societies have done, are doing and must do.

They all complimented the Mt. Purity for the step she took, being the youngest Lodge in town, hardly making her 7th month, and yet the only one of the five Samaritan Lodges to celebrate the day.

The Lodges represented were The Shepherds, Forresters, Free Gardeners, Star of Bethlehem, Mechanics, Mizpah and Concordia. Bro. Earle again dispersed sweet strains of music in company with Mr. Anibal Arosemena on his violin, with songs from Mr. Dan Hart and others, while wine, ice cream cakes and soft drinks were served at intervals. A very pleasant evening terminated at 11.30 p.m.

Too much praise cannot be given to Bros. D. R. Horton, Rowe, Roper, and Earle, also Sisters Fraser, Cuff, and Wright, as the promoters of a pleasant function to mark the era of prosperity of the Mt. Purity and the anniversary of the Order, while other Samaritans are kicking against the pricks.

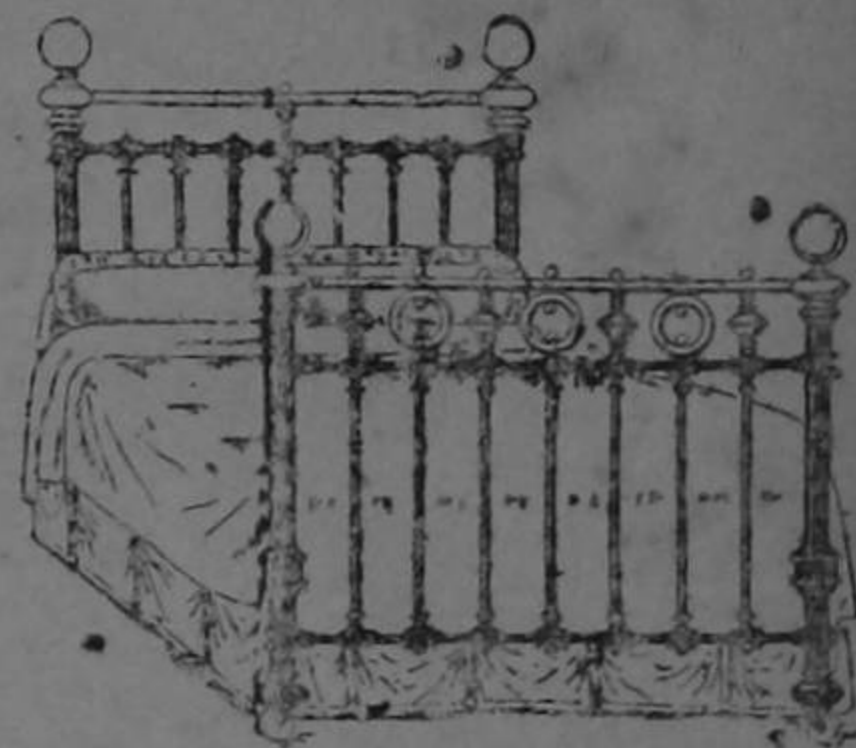
